GIVE BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF WHAT HAPPENED:

POLICE REPORT

On Tuesday, September 17, 2013, at approximately 10:22 pm, members of the Metropolitan Police Department were dispatched to the 100 block of Irvington Street, Southwest, Washington, DC, for the report of a shooting. Upon arrival to the scene, members located the decedent, Robert Spencer, lying unconscious near the sidewalk alongside of 134 Irvington Street, SW. The decedent, who was suffering from multiple gunshot wounds to the body that were consistent with a shotgun blast, was lying next to a wad from a fired shotgun shell and a steel projectile consistent with buckshot ammunition. The decedent was transported by DC FEMS to the Washington Hospital Center. While in route, a second steel projectile consistent with buckshot ammunition fell from the decedent's body to the ambulance floor. Upon arrival to the hospital, all life saving efforts proved futile and the decedent was pronounced dead at 10:59 pm by Doctor Abouassaly of staff. The decedent's remains were transported to the DC OCME pending a post-mortem examination and autopsy.

As the investigation progressed, investigators located and interviewed several witnesses to the offense. One such witness, hereinafter referred to as W-1, reports that while in the vicinity of the offense, IT observed a subject known as "Goose", pacing back and forth with a shotgun in a courtyard in front of 134 Irvington Street, SW. Shortly thereafter, W-1 observed "Goose" exit the courtyard and approach the decedent who was standing on the sidewalk adjacent to the building. During the approach, W-1 observed "Goose" rack the shotgun pump and state something to the effect of, "What's all that you saying?" W-1 observed "Goose" point the shotgun at the decedent and fire one shot. W-1 observed the decedent collapse to the ground. W-1 then observed "Goose" point the shotgun at a second individual that had taken cover behind a tree. Following this, W-1 observed "Goose" flee the area on foot.

W-1 was shown a photo array that contained a photograph of Defendant William Hogan and eight additional males. Upon viewing the array, W-1 identified Defendant William Hogan as "Goose" who committed the offense outline above.

A second witness, hereinafter referred to as W-2, reports that while in the vicinity of the offense, IT observed a subject known as "Goose" approach the decedent and state something to the effect of, "Oh, Oh, What's Up? What's up now?" W-2 observed "Goose" point a shotgun at the decedent and fire a single shot. W-2 observed the decedent collapse to the ground. W-2 observed "Goose" flee the area on foot while stating something to the effect of, "Yeah, Yeah."

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W-2 was shown a photo array that contained a photograph of Defendant William Hogan and eight additional males. Upon viewing the array, W-2 identified Defendant William Hogan as "Goose" who committed the offense outline above.

Based on the aforementioned facts and circumstances, the affiant submits that probable cause exists to believe that William Hogan utilized a shotgun and shot Decedent Robert Spencer. Although the official cause and manner of death has yet to be ruled by a forensic pathologist, the affiant submits that probable cause exists to believe that the gunshot wounds suffered by Decedent Robert Spencer as a result of the aforementioned shooting is the cause of his death. Therefore, the affiant respectfully request that a DC Superior Court Arrest Warrant be issued for Defendant William Hogan for the death of Decedent Robert Spencer. All events occurred in the District of Columbia.
