KEVIN A. WALKER, also known as Filet, within the District of Columbia, while armed with a firearm, purposely and with deliberate and premeditated malice, killed Jamie Jenkins by shooting her with a firearm on or about July 20, 2013, thereby causing injuries from which Jamie Jenkins died on or about July 20, 2013. (First Degree Murder While Armed (Premeditated), in violation of 22 D.C. Code, Sections 2101, 4502 (2001 ed.))

KEVIN A. WALKER, also known as Filet, within the District of Columbia, while armed with a firearm, purposely and with deliberate and premeditated malice, killed Jamahl Jenkins by shooting him with a firearm on or about July 20, 2013, thereby causing injuries from which Jamahl Jenkins died on or about July 20, 2013. (First Degree Murder While Armed (Premeditated), in violation of 22 D.C. Code, Sections 2101, 4502 (2001 ed.))

GIVE BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF WHAT HAPPENED:									
<p>On Saturday, July 20, 2013, at 0435 hours units from the Sixth District responded to the front of 5328 East Capitol St., NE, to investigate the report of two people shot in front of the location. Upon the arrival of the first officers, two victims were discovered lying on the sidewalk in front of 5328 East Capitol St., NE. Both victims were unconscious and unresponsive. The female victim was later identified as Jamie Jenkins, also known as "Seven" suffered a gunshot wound to the head, and was transported to Prince George's County Hospital by DCFEMS. The victim was pronounced dead at 0516 hours by Dr. Masha. Her remains were transported to the Office of the Chief Medical Examiner for the State of Maryland in Baltimore. The male victim, later identified as Jamahl Jenkins, who was suffering from multiple gunshot wounds, remained on the scene. His remains were transported to the Office of the Chief Medical Examiner for the District of Columbia pending an autopsy. The decedents are brother and sister.</p> <p>On Saturday, July 20, 2013, the D.C. Medical Examiner's Office performed an autopsy on the remains of Jamahl Jenkins. The autopsy was performed by Dr. Nikki Mourtzinis and assigned D.C. Medical Examiner case number 13-1861. Dr. Mourtzinis reports the decedent was shot, at least, six times, all from the back. Dr. Mourtzinis reports the cause of the death was "Multiple gunshot wounds to the body," and the manner of the death was a ruled a "Homicide."</p> <p>On Sunday, July 21, 2013, the State of MD Medical Examiner's office performed an autopsy on the remains of Jamie Jenkins. The autopsy was performed by Dr. Southhall, who after examination determined the cause of death to be "Single gunshot wound to the top of the head," and ruled the manner of death "Homicide."</p> <p>A witness was interviewed, hereinafter referred to as W-1. W-1 reported to the affiant that on Saturday, July 20, 2013, IT observed the decedent Jamie Jenkins and another woman fighting [The woman or female described fighting Jamie Jenkins has been identified by W-1, W-2, and W-3 by name and address and is the same person throughout this affidavit.] in front of 5328 East Capitol Street NE. W-1 reported the women eventually stopped</p>

fighting and separated. Subsequently, W-1 reported IT heard Jamie and her brother, Jamahl talking to a male wearing all black clothing. W-1 then observed the male display a handgun then shoot Jamie in the head. W-1 then observed the shooter turn the gun on Jamahl and fire multiple rounds at him while he was on the ground.

W-1 reported that the shooter's physical description reminded W-1 of a person the witness knows as "Filet." W-1 reported to the affiant that IT observed "Filet" a day or two before the shooting coming out of the female's residence who was fighting Jamie on July 30, 2013. Moreover, W-1 observed Filet a couple of times a week coming out of that location over numerous months. Based on the witness's personal knowledge, IT knows "Filet" was in a relationship with the female that was fighting Jamie and lived with her for numerous months.

W-1 was shown a single confirmation photograph depicting Kevin A. Walker, PDID: 517-607. W-1 positively identified Kevin A. Walker, PDID: 517-607 as the person IT knows as Filet.

Another witness was interviewed, hereinafter referred to as W-2. W-2 reported to your affiant that IT heard the female who had fought Jamie talking about the shooting of Jamie Jenkins and Jamahl Jenkins. W-2 reported that the female stated, "She went to her house to get her gun to shoot Jamie. When she was inside her home her boyfriend "Filet" told her to go back outside and that he would take care of it." W-2 was asked if IT had any personal knowledge of the subject named "Filet." W-2 reported that IT had seen Filet several times in the last year. W-2 also reported IT knew Filet and the female who was fighting Jamie were in a relationship and that he was living with the female for several years.

Based on the witness's personal knowledge of Filet, W-2 was shown a single confirmation photograph depicting Kevin A. Walker, PDID: 517-607. W-2 positively identified Kevin A. Walker, PDID: 517-607 as the person IT knows as Filet.

On August 30, 2013, W-3 was interviewed and reported to law enforcement that on Saturday, July 20, 2013, in the early morning hours, IT was outside in the 5300 block of East Capitol Street NE. W-3 reported IT observed a female fighting with the decedent, Jamie Jenkins. W-3 reported after the fight had stopped, IT observed a large build male wearing black clothing, including a black hooded garment walk to the female who was fighting Jamie and asked, "Who out here is threatening you?" or words to that effect. W-3 stated that the male's face was concealed by the hood, but W-3 recognized his stature and voice as that of Filet. According to W-3, Filet and the female fighting Jamie had a romantic relationship. Filet then approached Jamie and Jamahl. Jamie was standing in front of Jamahl. Jamie told the male individual, "You are not going to shoot my brother," or words to that effect. W-3 then noticed that Filet was holding a firearm in his hand. Filet replied, words to the effect, "I don't pull my gun out unless I'm going to use it." Jamahl responded, words to the effect, "I'm just trying to protect mine like you trying to protect yours." Filet then raised his firearm, pointing it in the direction of Jamie and Jamahl. According to W-3, Jamie jumped up as if to protect her brother and was shot in the head by Filet. Jamie fell to the ground. Jamahl attempted to turn and flee. Then, the defendant opened fired on Jamahl. After Jamahl fell to the ground, the defendant stood over him and continued firing as he lay on the ground.

W-3 reported IT recognized the shooter to be someone IT knows as "Filet". The witness reported IT has known Filet for approximately five years, and last saw him in the neighborhood one or two days prior to the shooting. W-3 was shown a single confirmation photograph depicting Kevin A. Walker, PDID: 517-607. W-3 immediately positively identified Kevin A. Walker, PDID: 517-607 as the person IT knows as Filet, the person who shot Jamie Jenkins and Jamahl Jenkins.

Prior to August 30, 2013, W-3 was interviewed. At that time, W-3 stated that IT recognized the shooter's build as Filet but did not disclose that Filet made statements and that W-3 recognized his voice. W-3 stated that IT did not disclose this information because it was afraid.

During the course of the investigation, a search warrant was executed on the residence of the female who was fighting Jamie. During the search of the premises evidence was recovered in the form of personal documents and mail matter bearing the name of Kevin A. Walker.


