All: Just an FYI on a Skid Row problem child that needs special attention. The infamous Anne Moody was released from her most recent 100 day jail sentence in the last two days. She immediately returned to the exact same location to conduct her illegal lodging, etc. She was arrested for Illegal Lodging yesterday, booking #2512308 and DR 10-0118624.

This is the Anne Moody that is an anchor for criminal activity on 6th street/Towne Ave and in the surrounding area, including Gladys Park which is one block away where children come and play during supervised after school visits, etc. She is a constant source of problems and complaints. She has taken numerous cases to jury trial and prior to this 100 day sentence had been arrested something like 16 times in 2009 and about 10 times or so in the first 4 months of this year. She simply thumbs her nose at the entire law enforcement and criminal justice system.

My officers will continue to arrest her immediately upon observing her conducting her illegal lodging and public nuisance activity. I will be retaining copies of arrest reports from this end as well in case they get lost in the system and don't reach you. Anything that can be done to drive forward constantly on her prosecutions would be of great assistance. I will be on vacation from 10/18 to 10/29, but Sgt Ronnie Crump (cc'd) will be available for any assistance that is needed.

Good afternoon, Lt. Paulson:

I wished to get back to you to confirm the result of the Annie Moody trial.

She was convicted on all 3 counts (41.18(D) LAMC; and 2 counts of 647(E) PC covering 2 separate dates of incident).

She was sentenced to a total 96 Days of county jail time. Ms. Moody had a total of 51 days credit as of 11/19--the date of sentencing.

Probation was denied by the Judge. As a result, Ms. Moody was not placed on summary probation.

Accordingly, the ability to impose a stay away order of any type was not available for the trial attorney to argue. The issue of probation for this type of charge is within the sole discretion of the Judge--as you know.

If Ms. Moody is arrested again for the same conduct the Officers need not flag this recent conviction in the body of the report. Our office is aware of Ms. Moody's past criminal convictions.

I am hopeful that this helps keep you updated.

Sir, I'm in Texas and Louisiana until Sat teaching with DHS. But did my morning check in with my guys. Squads 2 and 4 (Chave and Lizarraga) adjusted and ran a plainclothes/chase op yesterday afternoon and night and concentrated on San Julian park and perimeter and Street as well as Gladys Park. Ended up with 17 bodies for dope and various felony warrants and PALs. Good catch - they're running an Op again tonight. We have plans to run a sweep on San Julian next week too for 41.18 even without SOS. We're taking photographs to document the compounding problems in hopes it helps with some filings like we did when we hit the corner of 5th/Pedro.

We also arrested [REDACTED] this week after repeated warnings and Sgt Crump has communicated to the C/A tha [REDACTED] and finally, Anne Moody goes to jury trial once again this week for her last two arrests by Richter and my guys. We got it assigned to a C/A familiar with her history and who has handled a previous Moody trial.

Sir,

I just wanted to touch base after hearing about the nature of cross examination my personnel were subjected to in the most recent Anne Moody trial. It sounded to me like the defense attorney highly politicized the case in order to tug the heart strings of the jury. However, it also appeared the line of questioning was way beyond the purview of the personnel who were questioned. I would just ask, for the sake of future cases, that if such questions were posed again regarding the history of SCI, the annual statistics or statistical studies that have been conducted, etc. that I be called as a rebuttal witness.

These are not questions appropriately directed at my field supervisors or field personnel. I deal with management issues, am intimately familiar with the history and rationale for the formation of SCI, the overall social, political and law enforcement goals. I set the mission and policies, and I am the one that is constantly called to report and testify to City Council and the Police Commission on specifically those issues. I'm the one that has to compile the facts which contest the allegations made in supposed "reports" by individuals such as Dr. Gary Blase at UCLA and members of LA CAN. This is why in the recent LA City Attorney's effort to file a Skid Row Injunction (Central City East Injunction) I gave the declaration regarding the history of Skid Row and the SCI Unit. These issues are just most appropriately addressed to me - I don't expect my field supervisors to deal with such issues.

Anne Moody, and a few other similar individuals, are major problems to us, so we'd like to have the greatest success possible with such cases, as I'm sure your office would. I'd just like to offer myself up as the best resource for such issues.

As always, we greatly appreciate the effort and support from your office. I know these Skid Row cases aren't the biggest or sexiest cases. We're just trying to chip away at the biggest anchors to the blatant criminal activity in the area. Anything I can do to help, please don't hesitate to call on me.

I attended Anne Moody's arraignment today during which the judge granted her a O/R release pending her trial date. She has a conditional release which includes a STAY AWAY ORDER OF 200 YARDS from 6th Street and Towne Avenue. Officers Madarang and Marroquin are going to carefully measure the 200 yards and will be providing me the landmarks in each direction which indicate the boundary.

I have spoken with the C/A handling the case about how to better move forward with the Moody issues. While the arrest reports have been largely above average, they still lack some of the detail which could help us with a lock bang case against her and overcome some of the "not allowed to enter her history into court" barriers that we have to overcome.

I will be sending an email tonight to the SCI supervisors to pass on to you. This will have the details regarding Anne Moody's history, etc. which should be included, as well as proper articulation and details for the stay away order. I will make it largely a "cut and paste" exercise for you.

I attended Anne Moody's arraignment today during which the judge granted her a O/R release pending her trial date. She has a conditional release which includes a STAY AWAY ORDER OF 200 YARDS from 6th Street and Towne Avenue. Officers Madarang and Marroquin are going to carefully measure the 200 yards and will be providing me the landmarks in each direction which indicate the boundary.

I have spoken with the C/A handling the case about how to better move forward with the Moody issues. While the arrest reports have been largely above average, they still lack some of the detail which could help us with a lock bang case against her and overcome some of the "not allowed to enter her history into court" barriers that we have to overcome.

I will be sending an email tonight to the SCI supervisors to pass on to you. This will have the details regarding Anne Moody's history, etc. which should be included, as well as proper articulation and details for the stay away order. I will make it largely a "cut and paste" exercise for you.

Anne Moody has consistently and repeatedly established areas of public sidewalk as her personal lodging area, frequently for 24 hours per day. Moody frequently departs the area for lengthy periods of time, leaving her tent and bulky belongings spread along this portion of sidewalk.

This location where Anne Moody has most consistently set up her tent/lodging is against the north exterior wall of a fish packing business (Pacific Fish Company located at 700 E. 6th Street) and approximately 100 feet from their loading dock access (around the corner of the business). It is also is approximately 1 ½ blocks from the Para Los Ninos day care and elementary school and family support facility. It is approximately three blocks north of the 9th Street Elementary School (820 South Towne Avenue). Each Friday afternoon during the school year, students from this school walk north bound on Towne Avenue to 6th Street then 2 blocks east to Gladys Park for outdoor activities (the park is closed to the public for several hours on these Fridays to give the children full use of the facility). The children walk directly past Anne Moody's location and on frequent occasions have been witness to the activity surrounding her encampment and the

hazardous environment caused by her activities, including her personal waste collected in large 5 gallon buckets she and others utilize as toilets, etc.

Anne Moody insists on illegally lodging at this location despite the fact Gladys Park, located 1 ½ blocks west of her encampment, would provide a perfectly legal area for her to sit, lay or loiter during the daytime hours everyday (except those few hours on Friday afternoons). This park includes a publicly accessible automated/self cleaning toilet as well as numerous port-o-potties. An additional park, San Julian Park, is also open to the public during daytime hours and is located approximately 4 blocks west at San Julian and 5th Street. Frequenting either of these parks during the day would provide a legal alternative to setting up her encampment blocking the sidewalk and causing a visible nuisance to citizens, residents and businesses. Lieutenant Paulson (as well as numerous additional SCI officers) has personally advised Anne Moody of the availability of these parks during daytime hours, as well as the several open courtyards at the major missions along San Pedro and 6th Street, on numerous occasions.

Lieutenant Paulson also has personal knowledge of the repeated offers of shelter assistance and various programs which have been made to Anne Moody throughout the past two years. Ms Moody has at no time made any effort to comply with the law or take advantage of these sheltering and alternative options.

As a result of repeated arrests and prosecutions, Moody has departed the area of 6th Street and Towne Avenue and is now most frequently scene loitering in the area of 6th Street near San Julian Street and San Pedro Street.

Annie Moody has been a long term anchor problem within the Skid Row area, specifically at the corner of 6th St and Towne Avenue. In 2010 we arrested her no less than 16 times for LAMC violations and Illegal Lodging (PC Section) - she takes it to jury trial as she knows we will request a stay away order as a condition of probation, which would be part of any plea deal. In April 2011 we finally got a 180 day sentence on her, and another decent sentence in early 2012. We also were able to get a court ordered 200 yard stay away order as a condition of her O/R release in that one. We have repeatedly testified to our efforts to gain voluntary compliance, provide her with alternative housing, put her in contact with family, etc, which is what got the courts so upset and finally got her some decent sentences.

I've attached a narrative that I would require my officers to attach to all her arrest reports under "Additional." You may already have a copy of this. Bottom line - you can not work with her, she will not communicate and will not accept any offers of assistance, collaboration or reasonableness of any kind. We were left with no alternative to arrest, because she became known in the community as a symbol of non-compliance and an anchor for criminal activity.

Another important note - each and every time she was arrested she would have hundreds of dollars in her possession, as well as ATM receipts, almost always from a bank down on Crenshaw. She is not indigent or at least she doesn't need to be (she's refused to move in with her family despite their willingness) - she simply uses the homeless charade as a way to make tax free money through selling alcohol, untaxed cigarettes and crack pipes.

So, our solution was simply zero tolerance (having exhausted all other measures) and copious documentation and testimony to support why we were forced to waste the courts time with this.

Let me know if there's anything I can help with, testimony I can provide, etc.
