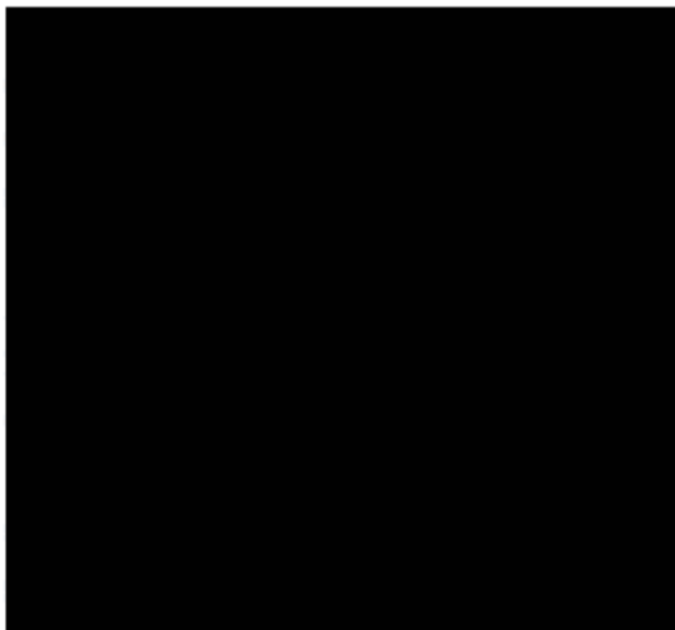

Good Afternoon Micki,

Sorry about calling you "Mr." – I should have picked that up because your name is spelled with an "i".

The City does accept mail at this main address – however, your request is still too broad. Any general mail the City receives gets routed to specific departments, so asking for all mail on a particular topic which also happens to be a large topic, that comes to that address would be virtually impossible to fulfil. I suggest you have a look at our website and research which department or work area you would like the information from. Your request is confusing because it mainly states what you do not want. In addition, the City does not have a "cabinet" so certain aspects of your requests do not apply and simply confuse the issue as to what it is you do want. For example, we cannot guarantee that any records we receive from a department for an FOI request won't necessitate a third party consultation.

It is the standard practice of our office to ask an applicant for clarification and simplification if a request is too broad or not specific enough.

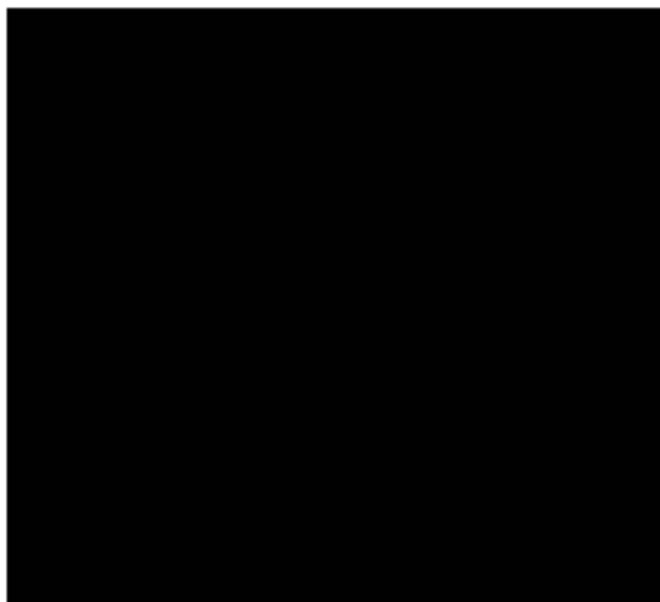



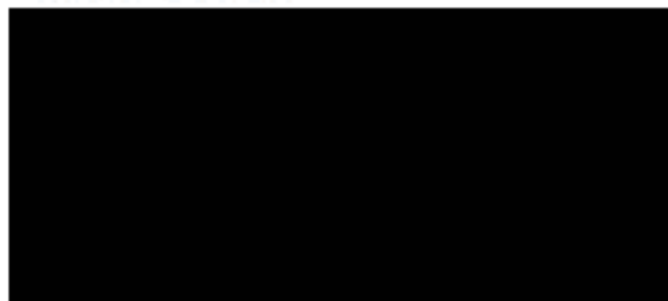

We have completed processing your informal request for:

A-2012-00325 – Last April it was reported that the federal government is closing B.C.'s command centre for emergency oil spills at a time when the province is facing two possible pipeline projects and a potential spike in tanker traffic in West Coast waterways.

Ottawa has said it will shut down B. C's regional office for emergency oil-spill responders, located in Vancouver and centralize operations in Quebec in the wake of the cost-cutting March 29 federal budget. The move could affect about 42 jobs in the B.C. Yukon region. The closing comes as pipeline operator Kinder Morgan says it hopes to increase capacity on its Edmonton-to-Burnaby Trans Mountain line, potentially increasing the number of oil tankers in Vancouver's harbor from roughly 70 a year to 360.

Please send me all your records since April 1, 2012 on the wisdom and advisability of this action, and the possible or likely consequences of it to British Columbia. Reports, memos, correspondence, etc. Do not send media clippings, nor any records in French.

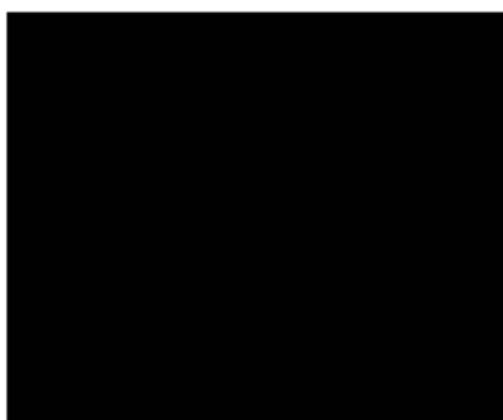

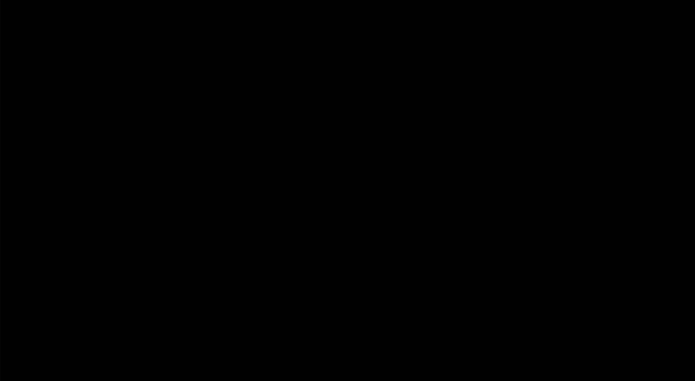

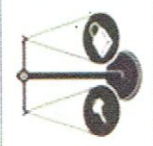
