





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GIVE BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF WHAT HAPPENED: POLICE REPORT: That on or about Saturday, March 1, 2014, in the 300 block of Ridge Road, Southeast, Antonio J. Williams a/k/a Jamal [herein after referred to as Defendant] was involved in a conversation with Andre Derrick McIntyre, [hereinafter referred to as Decedent] and assaulted the Decedent causing the Decedent to fall and strike his head. The Decedent died as a result of the assault. INVESTIGATION: That on Saturday, March 1, 2014, at approximately 0006 hours, the Office of Unified Communication (OUC) received a 911 call indicating that an individual was unconscious and suffered a head injury in either the 300 block of Ridge Road, SE or the 3700 block of D Street, SE. Engine 30 and Ambulance 27 from the District of Columbia Fire and Emergency Medical Services Department (DCFEMS) were dispatched to the scene. DCFEMS discovered the Decedent sitting up against a fence in the 300 block of Ridge Road, SE with at least two individuals in close proximity who appeared to be assisting the Decedent. DCFEMS observed the Decedent to be in an unconscious state with apparent trauma to his head. Further examination by DCFEMS discovered that the Decedent was in cardiac arrest and that his head injury may have been the result of a gunshot. DCFEMS informed their dispatcher that they believed the Decedent was suffering from a gunshot wound to the head and that Metropolitan Police Department [MPD] needed to respond. The Decedent was transported to Prince Georges County Hospital for medical treatment but eventually succumbed to his injuries. The decedent was pronounced dead at 0133 hours by Dr. Schechner of the hospital staff. The hospital staff could not definitively say whether the trauma to the head was caused by a gunshot wound, fall, etc. On Saturday, March 1, 2014, Dr. Melissa Brassell of the Maryland Office of the Chief Medical Examiner's Office (OCME) performed an autopsy on the decedent. Dr. Brassell noted a laceration to the left side of the decedent's face near the chin and trauma to the hyoid bone which are consistent with a punch but not definitive as the cause of those injuries. Dr. Brassell determined the cause of death was blunt force trauma of the head and neck and																									

ruled the manner of death as a HOMICIDE.

During the investigation, a witness, hereinafter W-1, was interviewed. W-1 reported that IT was walking in the 300 block of Ridge Road SE with the decedent, but that IT was walking several yards ahead of the decedent. According to W-1, IT turned around and saw the decedent lying on the sidewalk. W-1 reported that IT believed that the decedent fell down but did not know how the decedent ended up on the ground.

Another witness, hereinafter referred to as W-2, was interviewed. Initially W-2 reported to law enforcement that IT was in the area when IT saw the decedent lying on the sidewalk, unconscious and bleeding from the back of his head. However, W-2 denied knowing what caused the decedent to be lying on the sidewalk, unconscious and bleeding.

W-2 was later re-interviewed and reported that as IT was in the area of the intersection of Ridge Road SE and D Street SE, IT saw the decedent, W-1 and a person IT knew as "Jamal" standing on the sidewalk near the intersection. W-2 reported that IT heard the decedent say "Come here Jamal" and saw the person IT knew as Jamal approach the decedent. W-2 observed a conversation between the decedent and Jamal, but could not hear what the two were saying. Shortly thereafter, W-2 reported that Jamal turned to walk away but then he spun around and struck the decedent in the facial area with a closed fist. The decedent immediately fell and struck his head on the ground. According to W-2, Jamal immediately got into a vehicle and left the scene. W-2 saw Jamal return after the police and EMTs arrived, and heard Jamal ask "Is Dre alright?" before again leaving the scene.

W-2 reported that IT later heard that the decedent owed Jamal money for drugs bought on credit and that drug debt was the subject of the conversation between Jamal and the decedent before Jamal hit the decedent.

Through this investigation, your affiant learned that "Jamal" is a known alias for Antonio Jemar Williams, the defendant.

W-2 was shown a single confirmation photo of Antonio Jemar Williams, PDID: 596-582, which IT positively identified as "Jamal," someone IT has known longer than a year.

Another witness, hereinafter W-3, was interviewed. W-3 reported that IT, too, was aware that the decedent owed money to Jamal and IT heard from W-2 that Jamal hit the decedent after a discussion about that drug debt. W-3 was shown a single confirmation photo of Antonio Jemar Williams, PDID: 596-582, which IT positively identified as Jamal, someone IT has known longer than a year. Furthermore, W-3 stated that IT heard W-1 state that the decedent was taking drugs and fell.

Based on the facts set forth in the Affidavit, your affiant believes that probably cause exists, and respectfully requests that a judge of the District of Columbia Superior Court issue a warrant for Antonio J. Williams, also known as Jamal, PDID 596582.
