The Grand Jury charges:

FIRST COUNT:

Donald Dubose, also known as "Moose" or "Toast", within the District of Columbia, while armed with a firearm, purposely and with deliberate and premeditated malice, killed Michael Smith by shooting him with a firearm on or about May 12, 2012, thereby causing injuries from which Michael Smith died on or about May 12, 2012. (First Degree Murder While Armed (Premeditated), in violation of 22 D.C. Code, Sections 2101, 4502 (2001 ed.))

SECOND COUNT:


On or about May 12, 2012, within the District of Columbia, Donald Dubose, also known as "Moose" or "Toast", did possess a firearm while committing the crime of Murder as set forth in the first count of this indictment. (Possession Of a Firearm During Crime Of Violence Or Dangerous Offense, in violation of 22 D.C. Code, Section 4504(b) (2001 ed.))

THIRD COUNT:

On or about May 12, 2012, within the District of Columbia, Donald Dubose, also known as "Moose" or "Toast", while armed with and having readily available a pistol or other firearm or imitation thereof assaulted Larry Gilbert with intent to kill him. (Assault With Intent To Kill While Armed, in violation of 22 D.C. Code, Section 401, 4502 (2001 ed.))


FOURTH COUNT:

On or about May 12, 2012, within the District of Columbia, Donald Dubose, also known as "Moose" or "Toast", did possess a firearm while committing the crime of Assault with Intent to Kill as set forth in the third count of this indictment. (Possession Of a Firearm During Crime Of Violence Or Dangerous Offense, in violation of 22 D.C. Code, Section 4504(b) (2001 ed.))
