The Grand Jury charges:

FIRST COUNT:

Erik Postell, within the District of Columbia, while armed with a firearm, purposely and with deliberate and premeditated malice, killed Paul Tanoh-Danzo by shooting him with a firearm on or about March 21, 2013, thereby causing injuries from which Paul Tanoh-Danzo died on or about March 21, 2013. (First Degree Murder While Armed (Premeditated), in violation of 22 D.C. Code, Sections 2101, 4502 (2001 ed.))

SECOND COUNT:

On or about March 21, 2013, within the District of Columbia, Erik Postell did possess a firearm while committing the crime of murder as set forth in the first count of this indictment. (Possession Of a Firearm During Crime Of Violence Or Dangerous Offense, in violation of 22 D.C. Code, Section 4504(b) (2001 ed.))

THIRD COUNT:

On or about March 20, 2013, within the District of Columbia, Erik Postell, previously having been convicted in any court of a crime punishable by imprisonment for a term exceeding one year, owned, kept, and had within his possession and control, a firearm. (Unlawful Possession of a Firearm (Prior Conviction), in violation of 22 D.C. Code, Section 4503 (a)(1) (2001 ed.))

FOURTH COUNT:


On or about March 21, 2013, within the District of Columbia, Erik Postell, previously having been convicted in any court of a crime punishable by imprisonment for a term exceeding one year, owned, kept, and had within his possession and control, a firearm. (Unlawful Possession of a Firearm (Prior Conviction), in violation of 22 D.C. Code, Section 4503 (a)(1) (2001 ed.))

FIFTH COUNT:

On or about March 20, 2013, within the District of Columbia, Erik Postell did carry, openly and concealed on or about his person, in a place other than his dwelling place, place of business or on other land possessed by him, a pistol. (Carrying a Pistol (Outside Home or Place of Business), in violation of 22 D.C. Code, Section 4504(a), (2) (2001 ed.))

SIXTH COUNT:

On or about March 21, 2013, within the District of Columbia, Erik Postell did carry, openly and concealed on or about his person, in a place other than his dwelling place, place of business or on other land possessed by him, a pistol. (Carrying a Pistol (Outside Home or Place of Business), in violation of 22 D.C. Code, Section 4504(a), (2) (2001 ed.))
