Wynyard Quarter Residential Profile

Overview

Willis Bond & Co has been chosen through an international design and tender process to develop the first residential precinct at Wynyard Quarter. Willis Bond was selected by Waterfront Auckland as its residential development partner to create and deliver a truly vibrant and diverse community at Wynyard Quarter.

The residential precinct will be situated in two areas in the heart of Auckland's regenerated Wynyard Quarter; a waterfront site on the corner of Hasley and Madden Streets, next to the soon to be constructed Auckland Theatre Company building and overlooking the Viaduct Harbour; and four central sites between Daldy, Beaumont, Madden and Pakenham Streets, fronting the new Daldy Street linear park. The precinct will offer a diverse selection of over 500 new apartments, townhouses and duplexes, and will include retail and boutique office spaces on the ground levels.

Willis Bond has assembled an exceptional project team that have worked on some of New Zealand's biggest residential projects. The design team is of genuine international standing, including three of New Zealand's best architectural practices: Architectus, Athfield Architects and Studio Pacific Architecture.

The Willis Bond-led team have developed a master plan for a world-class, sustainable urban village at Wynyard Quarter, which includes a variety of residential styles connected by lanes, thoroughfares and open public spaces. Public and green spaces are celebrated and are readily accessible for visitors and residents alike. Permeating every aspect of the design are sustainability principles.

Sustainability will be one of Wynyard Quarter's defining features and we plan to make the residential precinct a place where ideas about 21st century sustainable living are made real. Every residence will be designed to meet a minimum 7 star Homestar standard.

Key Figures

The development comprises:

- Five sites with a combined land area of just over two hectares.
- Approximately 17 buildings.
- A mixture of 500-600 apartments, town houses and duplexes of various sizes and at a range of price points.

Project Timeline

The Willis Bond residential development is an 8-10 year project. The residential offerings in the initial stages of development will be available to purchase off the plans by late 2014, and constructed by late 2017. Further releases will be made over the course of the project.
