On Friday, October 3rd, 2014, Judge Clay Lewis Jenkins assisted the members of the household in which a patient with Ebola virus disease had been staying to relocate. The household members had been actively monitored that day as contacts of the Ebola patient in Dallas and were known to be afebrile and asymptomatic. They were neither ill, nor infectious. Judge Jenkins' action in moving them posed no danger of Ebola to himself or to anyone else and was consistent with good public health practice.
