

Georgia

In Georgia, interviews with 1,009 adult Americans conducted by telephone by ORC International on October 19-22, 2014. The margin of sampling error for results based on the total sample is plus or minus 3 percentage points. The Georgia sample also includes 822 interviews among registered voters (plus or minus 3.5 percentage points) and 565 interviews among likely voters (plus or minus 4 percentage points). In Georgia, 706 interviews were conducted among landline respondents and 303 interviews among cell phone respondents.

METHODOLOGY

In Georgia, a total of 1,009 adults were interviewed by telephone. All respondents were asked questions concerning basic demographics, and the entire sample was weighted to reflect statewide Census figures for gender, race, age, education and region of the state. Registered voters were asked questions about their likelihood of voting, past voting behavior, and interest in the campaign; based on the answers to those questions, 565 respondents were classified as likely voters. Among those likely voters, 38% described themselves as Democrats, 32% described themselves as Independents, and 30% described themselves as Republicans.

Crosstabs on the following pages only include results for subgroups with enough unweighted cases to produce a sampling error of +/- 8.5 percentage points or less. Some subgroups represent too small a share of the population of Georgia to produce crosstabs with an acceptable sampling error. Interviews were conducted among these subgroups but results for groups with a sampling error larger than +/-8.5 percentage points are not displayed.
