IN THE CIRCUIT COURT FOR BALTIMORE COUNTY

The Jurors of the State of Maryland, for the body of Baltimore County, do on their oath present that TERRENCE BERNARD CODY, on and between 12/19/2014 and 1/19/2015, in Baltimore County, did intentionally torture an animal, to wit: "Taz" (Male, Brindle, Presa Canarios Mastiff); against the peace, government and dignity of the State.

(Aggravated Animal Cruelty, Criminal Law Article 10-606(a)(1), 1 0505)

***This charge is classified as a Felony and is a jailable offense with a maximum penalty of incarceration up to 3 years and fines of up to \$5000.00.***

SECOND COUNT

And the Jurors of the State of Maryland, for the body of Baltimore County, do on their oath present that TERRENCE BERNARD CODY, on and between 12/19/2014 and 1/19/2015, in Baltimore County, did intentionally cruelly kill an animal, to wit: "Taz" (Male, Brindle, Presa Canarios Mastiff); against the peace, government and dignity of the State.

(Aggravated Animal Cruelty, Criminal Law Article 10-606(a)(1), 1 0505)

***This charge is classified as a Felony and is a jailable offense with a maximum penalty of incarceration up to 3 years and fines of up to \$5000.00.***

THIRD COUNT

And the Jurors of the State of Maryland, for the body of Baltimore County, do on their oath present that TERRENCE BERNARD CODY, on and between 12/19/2014 and 1/19/2015, in Baltimore County, did inflict unnecessary suffering or pain on an animal, to wit: "Taz" (Male, Brindle, Presa Canarios Mastiff); against the peace, government and dignity of the State.

(Animal Abuse/Neglect, Criminal Law Article 10-604, 1 0503)

***This charge is classified as a Misdemeanor and is a jailable offense with a maximum penalty of incarceration up to 90 days and fines of up to \$1000.00.***

FOURTH COUNT

And the Jurors of the State of Maryland, for the body of Baltimore County, do on their oath present that TERRENCE BERNARD CODY, on and between 12/19/2014 and 1/19/2015, in Baltimore County, did unnecessarily fail to provide the animal with nutritious food in sufficiency quantity, to wit: "Taz" (Male, Brindle, Presa Canarios Mastiff); against the peace, government and dignity of the State.

(Animal Abuse/Neglect, Criminal Law Article 10-604, 1 0503)

***This charge is classified as a Misdemeanor and is a jailable offense with a maximum penalty of incarceration up to 90 days and fines of up to \$1000.00.***

#### FIFTH COUNT

And the Jurors of the State of Maryland, for the body of Baltimore County, do on their oath present that TERRENCE BERNARD CODY, on and between 12/19/2014 and 1/19/2015, in Baltimore County, did unnecessarily fail to provide the animal with necessary veterinary care, to wit: "Taz" (Male, Brindle, Presa Canarios Mastiff); against the peace, government and dignity of the State.

(Animal Abuse/Neglect, Criminal Law Article 10-604, 1 0503)

***This charge is classified as a Misdemeanor and is a jailable offense with a maximum penalty of incarceration up to 90 days and fines of up to \$1000.00.***

#### SIXTH COUNT

And the Jurors of the State of Maryland, for the body of Baltimore County, do on their oath present that TERRENCE BERNARD CODY, on and between 12/19/2014 and 1/19/2015, in Baltimore County, did unnecessarily fail to provide the animal with proper drink, to wit: "Taz" (Male, Brindle, Presa Canarios Mastiff); against the peace, government and dignity of the State.

(Animal Abuse/Neglect, Criminal Law Article 10-604, 1 0503)

***This charge is classified as a Misdemeanor and is a jailable offense with a maximum penalty of incarceration up to 90 days and fines of up to \$1000.00.***

#### SEVENTH COUNT

And the Jurors of the State of Maryland, for the body of Baltimore County, do on their oath present that TERRENCE BERNARD CODY, on and between 12/19/2014 and 1/19/2015, in Baltimore County, did unnecessarily fail to provide the animal with proper space, to wit: "Taz" (Male, Brindle, Presa Canarios Mastiff); against the peace, government and dignity of the State.

(Animal Abuse/Neglect, Criminal Law Article 10-604, 1 0503)

***This charge is classified as a Misdemeanor and is a jailable offense with a maximum penalty of incarceration up to 90 days and fines of up to \$1000.00.***

#### EIGHTH COUNT

And the Jurors of the State of Maryland, for the body of Baltimore County, do on their oath present that TERRENCE BERNARD CODY, on and between 12/19/2014 and 1/19/2015, in Baltimore County, did import into Maryland, as a household pet, a live Alligator; against the peace, government and dignity of the State.

(Possession of Alligator, Criminal Law Article 10-621, 7 7199)

***This charge is classified as a Misdemeanor with a maximum penalty of fines of up to \$1000.00.***

#### NINTH COUNT

And the Jurors of the State of Maryland, for the body of Baltimore County, do on their oath present that TERRENCE BERNARD CODY, on and between 12/19/2014 and 1/19/2015, in Baltimore County, did unnecessarily fail to provide the animal with nutritious food in sufficiency quantity, to wit: an Alligator; against the peace, government and dignity of the State.

(Animal Abuse/Neglect, Criminal Law Article 10-604, 1 0503)

***This charge is classified as a Misdemeanor and is aailable offense with a maximum penalty of incarceration up to 90 days and fines of up to \$1000.00.***

#### TENTH COUNT

And the Jurors of the State of Maryland, for the body of Baltimore County, do on their oath present that TERRENCE BERNARD CODY, on and between 12/19/2014 and 1/19/2015, in Baltimore County, did unnecessarily fail to provide the animal with necessary veterinary care, to wit: an Alligator; against the peace, government and dignity of the State.

(Animal Abuse/Neglect, Criminal Law Article 10-604, 1 0503)

***This charge is classified as a Misdemeanor and is aailable offense with a maximum penalty of incarceration up to 90 days and fines of up to \$1000.00.***

#### ELEVENTH COUNT

And the Jurors of the State of Maryland, for the body of Baltimore County, do on their oath present that TERRENCE BERNARD CODY, on and between 12/19/2014 and 1/19/2015, in Baltimore County, did unnecessarily fail to provide the animal with proper space, to wit: an Alligator; against the peace, government and dignity of the State.

(Animal Abuse/Neglect, Criminal Law Article 10-604, 1 0503)

***This charge is classified as a Misdemeanor and is aailable offense with a maximum penalty of incarceration up to 90 days and fines of up to \$1000.00.***

#### TWELFTH COUNT

And the Jurors of the State of Maryland, for the body of Baltimore County, do on their oath present that TERRENCE BERNARD CODY, on and between 12/19/2014 and 1/19/2015, in Baltimore County, did unnecessarily fail to provide the animal with proper shelter, to wit: an Alligator; against the peace, government and dignity of the State.

(Animal Abuse/Neglect, Criminal Law Article 10-604, 1 0503)

***This charge is classified as a Misdemeanor and is aailable offense with a maximum penalty of incarceration up to 90 days and fines of up to \$1000.00.***

### THIRTEENTH COUNT

And the Jurors of the State of Maryland, for the body of Baltimore County, do on their oath present that TERRENCE BERNARD CODY, on and between 12/19/2014 and 1/19/2015, in Baltimore County, did unnecessarily fail to provide the animal with proper drink, to wit: an Alligator; against the peace, government and dignity of the State. (Animal Abuse/Neglect, Criminal Law Article 10-604, 1 0503)

***This charge is classified as a Misdemeanor and is a jailable offense with a maximum penalty of incarceration up to 90 days and fines of up to \$1000.00.***

### FOURTEENTH COUNT

And the Jurors of the State of Maryland, for the body of Baltimore County, do on their oath present that TERRENCE BERNARD CODY, on or about 1/22/2015, in Baltimore County, did possess with intent to use drug paraphernalia, to wit: a gas mask with smoking attachment, 3 glass smoking pipes, and a long green smoking device used to introduce into the human body a controlled dangerous substance of Schedule I, to wit: Marijuana; against the peace, government and dignity of the State. (Possession with Intent to Use Drug Paraphernalia, Criminal Law Article 5-619(d)(1), 5 3550)

***This charge is classified as a Misdemeanor with a maximum penalty of fines of up to \$500.00.***


### FIFTEENTH COUNT


And the Jurors of the State of Maryland, for the body of Baltimore County, do on their oath present that TERRENCE BERNARD CODY, on or about 1/22/2015, in Baltimore County, did possess a controlled dangerous substance of Schedule I, to wit: Marijuana, in an amount of at least 10 grams; against the peace, government and dignity of the State. (Possession of Marijuana, Criminal Law Article 5-601(a)(1), 1 0573)

***This charge is classified as a Misdemeanor and is a jailable offense with a maximum penalty of incarceration up to 1 years and fines of up to \$1000.00.***

TO THE PERSON CHARGED:

1. This paper charges you with committing a crime.
2. If you have been arrested, you have the right to have a judicial officer decide whether you should be released from jail until your trial.
3. You have the right to have a lawyer.
4. A lawyer can be helpful to you by:
  - (A) explaining the charges in this paper;
  - (B) telling you the possible penalties;
  - (C) helping you at trial;
  - (D) helping you protect your constitutional rights; and
  - (E) helping you to get a fair penalty if convicted.
5. Even if you plan to plead guilty, a lawyer can be helpful.
6. If you want a lawyer but do not have the money to hire one, the Public Defender may provide a lawyer for you. The Court Clerk will tell you how to contact the Public Defender.
7. If you want a lawyer but you cannot get one and the Public Defender will not provide one for you, contact the Court Clerk as soon as possible.
8. DO NOT WAIT UNTIL THE DATE OF YOUR TRIAL TO GET A LAWYER. If you do not have a lawyer before the trial date, you may have to go to trial without one.
