This offense occurred at 3815 East Side Avenue, Dallas, Dallas County, Texas.

Complainant \_\_\_\_\_ made an appointment for buttocks injections with a person she knew only as "Wee Wee". The scheduled appointment was made over the phone and she agreed to pay \$520.00 for her first session. On February 9, 2015, Complainant \_\_\_\_\_ called "Wee Wee" to confirm the appointment and to get the address where she would get the injections. Complainant \_\_\_\_\_ was given an address on East Side Ave, and detectives determined it to be 3815 East Side Avenue, Dallas, TX. After arriving to the location, Complainant \_\_\_\_\_ waited her turn and was escorted into a back room. Suspect Jimmy Clarke (AKA: Alicia) told Complainant \_\_\_\_\_ to remove her pants and to lay on the table. Complainant \_\_\_\_\_ attempted to ask questions about the procedure, such as what was being used in the injections and she was not given a good explanation. Complainant \_\_\_\_\_ stated that while she was on the table, Suspects Ross and Clarke sanitized her buttocks and then started the injections. Complainant \_\_\_\_\_ said that Suspect Ross injected syringes into the left side of her buttocks and Suspect Clarke injected syringes into the right side of her buttocks.

Complainant \_\_\_\_\_ said that while the procedure was going on, the syringes never came out; they were just refilled with an unknown liquid. Complainant \_\_\_\_\_ had three syringes on one side and four on the other side of her buttocks. Complainant \_\_\_\_\_ was told by "Wee Wee" that the liquid was a water based saline and Complainant \_\_\_\_\_ asked if it was Hydro Gel and "Wee Wee" responded "yes".

During the procedure, Complainant \_\_\_\_\_ felt intense pain and was told to be quiet after screaming in agony. When the procedure concluded, the injection holes were closed with super glue and cotton balls. Complainant \_\_\_\_\_ was given two tubes of super glue to take home with her so that she could stop any of the liquid injected into her body from leaking out. Complainant \_\_\_\_\_ said that during the procedure she felt severe pain and is currently suffering psychological side effects and soreness in her body.

Complainant \_\_\_\_\_ was shown a color six photo line-up containing one photo of Suspect Jimmy Clarke and she was able to positively identify Jimmy Clarke as the person who injected her.

Complainant \_\_\_\_\_ was shown a color six photo line-up containing one photo of Suspect Denise Ross and after a long pause on Suspect Denise Ross' photo, was unable to positively identify her as "Wee Wee"

During the investigation, Detective Tabor was able to identify the person known as "Wee Wee" as Suspect Denise Ross. The phone number Complainant \_\_\_\_\_ used to call "Wee Wee" was the same number Detective Tabor had for Denise Ross. Witness \_\_\_\_\_ who rented the location for Suspects Ross and Clarke also identified Denise Ross as "Wee Wee".


