ARREST WARRANT AFFIDAVIT

COUNTY OF ELLIS

BEFORE ME, the undersigned authority, on this day personally appeared the undersigned affiant, who after being duly sworn on oath deposes and says; My name is Adam Sweaney of the Texas Department of Public Safety, and I have good reason to believe and do believe that on or about the 20th, in the month of January, 2015, and March 31st, 2015, William "Billy" Getzendaner, White Male, [REDACTED] driver's license number [REDACTED] date of birth 07-07-1980, did then and there commit the offense of:

Tampering With a Witness, PC: 36.05 (1st Degree Felony)

On Tuesday, 03-31-2015, the complainant (who was given the pseudonym John Doe #72, and will be identified as such through the investigation), filed an offense report with Ellis County Sheriff's Office Deputy Corporal Joshua Atilano #285, stating that he was sexually assaulted at the Ellis County Emergency Service District #6 Volunteer Fire Station (ESD #6) located at 1816 FM 66, Waxahachie, Texas. John Doe #72 stated that on 01-20-2015, Black Jerold Tucker, Casey Joe Stafford, and Keith Edward Wisakowsky bent him down over a couch and held him face down. Keith Wisakowsky left to retrieve a package of chorizo sausage from a refrigerator. Black Tucker and Casey Stafford held him down and pulled his pants down exposing his anus. Keith returned and inserted the foreign object (chorizo sausage) inside his rectum causing him pain. John Doe #72 stated that the chorizo sausage was removed from his anus and cut out of the package with a knife by Keith Wisakowsky. John Doe #72 stated that Keith Wisakowsky gave the chorizo sausage to Blake Tucker who then attempted to place the sausage back into his rectum but it did not penetrate him. John Doe #72 stated he was then released and he crawled into a nearby bathroom with the smashed up sausage still in-between his butt cheeks and threw up. John Doe #72 stated he removed the sausage from his butt cheeks and took a shower to clean up. While John Doe #72 was taking a shower an unknown person took his clothing from the bathroom. John Doe #72 stated he exited the bathroom in a towel looking for his clothes and Blake Tucker took his towel causing him to have to cover his genitals with his hands. John Doe #72 stated he ran out of the building to his vehicle to retrieve some shorts.

Ranger Adam Sweaney and Ellis County Criminal Investigator Joe M. Fitzgerald #288 interviewed witness Preston Thomas Peyrot. During the interview Peyrot said he retrieved a wooden stick "broom stick" and gave the "broom stick" to Keith Wisakowsky. Preston Thomas Peyrot explained this was the first object they tried to use to stick into John Doe 72's rectum. Peyrot said Blake Jerold Tucker, Casey Joe Stafford, Keith Edward Wisakowsky and he continued to hold John Doe 72 down and put the "broom stick" under his pants and in-between his butt cheeks. The broom stick did not penetrate his anus. During the concert of the act one (1) of the parties said "I have something better" and went to the refrigerator and returned with the chorizo sausage.

Ranger Adam Sweaney and Ellis County Criminal Investigator Joe M. Fitzgerald #288 spoke with witness Alec Chase Miller. Miller was instructed the interview was on his own free will and he could leave at any time during our discussions. As we discussed the above mentioned act he explained he knowingly participated and regretted his actions. Miller said he held the "broom stick" and continued to poke John Doe 72 in the area of his leg and butt. Miller said he was standing with Blake Jerold Tucker, Preston Thomas Peyrot, Casey Joe Stafford, and Keith Edward Wisakowsky. Miller said Brittany Leanne Parten was videoing the incident with her cell phone.

Ranger Adam Sweaney received cell phone video which depicted the aforementioned acts. Brittany Leanne Parten was identified as the videographer and used her cell phone to record. All the parties are seen on video and overheard yelling and laughing with excitement. Preston Thomas Peyrot witnessed Brittany Leanne Parten videoing the acts.


As a result of these acts, Emergency Service District #6 Chief Gavin Lawrence Satterfield and ESD #6 Assistant Chief William "Billy" Getzendaner held a private meeting at the ESD #6 Volunteer Fire Department. Chief Satterfield and Assistant Chief Getzendaner held the meeting inside their office. The prospective witnesses Black Jerold Tucker, Casey Joe Stafford, Keith Edward Wisakowsky, Preston Thomas Peyrot, Alec Chase Miller, and John Doe #72 were called to attend the meeting. John Doe #72 said Assistant Chief Getzendaner laughed and chuckled stating he saw the video and made the statement, "This is funny shit." John Doe #72 stated that Assistant Chief Getzendaner followed his statement up with, "We can't be sticking chorizo up John Doe #72's butt." John Doe #72 said the prospective witnesses and Assistant Chief Getzendaner laughed at his comments together. John Doe #72 stated that Assistant Chief Getzendaner informed the prospective witnesses that John Doe #72 could do something to "us" and looked at John Doe #72, and said, "But you're not going to." John Doe #72 realized neither Assistant Chief Getzendaner nor Chief Satterfield were going to take any disciplinary actions towards the actors. Assistant Chief Getzendaner told the prospective witnesses that this could be a Sexual Assault, to keep the knowledge of the sexual assault in-house, delete the video, and keep their mouths shut.

During the interviews of the prospective witnesses, Ranger Sweaney and Investigator Fitzgerald were informed that Assistant Chief Getzendaner and Chief Satterfield advised the actors and the victim, that if they did not heed their instructions to withhold information regarding the sexual assault from person(s) outside of the ESD #6 Fire Department, there would be consequences because law enforcement would investigate this as a Sexual Assault.

That based upon the facts being related to him as a result of this investigation your affiant has reason to believe and does believe that William "Billy" Getzendaner committed the offense of **Tampering with a Witness, PC: 36.05 (1st Degree Felony)**

WHEREFORE, I request that an arrest warrant issue for the suspect hereinbefore designated according to the laws of this State.
