


COUNT 1

**AFFIDAVIT IN SUPPORT OF PROBABLE CAUSE  
PURSUANT TO M.R.Crim.P. 4A**

I, Kristopher Kennedy, a Detective with the Maine State Police, do hereby state under oath that I have probable cause to believe and do believe that CONNOR S. MACCALISTER [REDACTED] Saco, Maine, has committed the crime of Murder MRSA 17-A 201-A. Your affiant bases this assertion on the following facts and circumstances:


1. On 8/19/15 at 3:09 PM, your affiant learned that Saco dispatchers received a radio transmission from a rescue member at Shaw's Supermarket at 4 Scammon Street in that a stabbing. Upon arrival, the responding officers found a female in the ice cream aisle who suffered an obvious injury to her neck area. In the same aisle was a male holding down a female dressed in camouflage with a shaved head. The camouflaged female was later identified as CONNOR S. MACCALISTER, [REDACTED] Saco.
2. Your affiant learned that the victim, later identified as WENDY A. BOUDREAU, [REDACTED] suffered a stab wound to her face and neck. She was transported to Southern Maine Health Center where she was pronounced dead.
3. Your affiant learned that ALEXANDRA "SANDY" GOGOS, [REDACTED] was a witness to the stabbing. She is an employee who was working in the bakery department at the end of the ice cream aisle when she heard screaming. She looked up and saw a female wearing camouflage with a shaved head standing over another female, who was sitting on the floor, slumped over. She saw the female wearing camouflage stab the older female in the facial area. GOGOS ran over and attempted to stop the bleeding. As she did, she asked MACCALISTER, "Why? Why did you do this?" GOGOS said MACCALISTER replied, "She looked at me funny."
4. Your affiant learned that BENJAMIN WILLIAMS [REDACTED] was several aisles down when he heard screaming. He ran over and saw a female on the floor covered in blood with another female dressed in camouflage standing over her. WILLIAMS ordered the camouflaged female to the ground. WILLIAMS said another male ran up and asked the camouflaged female, "Why did you do this?" She replied, "I'm off my meds. She looked at me wrong."
5. Your affiant learned that KATELYN TALMER, [REDACTED] was near the pharmacy when she heard screaming. She ran down the aisle and heard someone yelling, "She's been stabbed!" She saw a female on the floor bleeding from the neck with a female standing over her wearing camouflage with her head shaved. She heard someone ask the camouflaged female, "Why did you do it?" The camouflaged female replied, "Because she looked at me funny." TALMER said the camouflaged female seemed perfectly calm and relaxed. TALMER said she saw a knife on the floor near where the camouflaged female was standing and kicked it away.
6. Your affiant learned that THOMAS WRIGHT, [REDACTED] was in the next aisle when he heard screaming. He ran over and saw a female in camouflage with a shaved head standing near another female on the floor bleeding. WRIGHT said the camouflaged female looked like she was in awe, staring at the female on the floor. WRIGHT asked the camouflaged female, "Why did you do that?!" She replied, "I'm off my meds and I didn't mean to do it. She looked at me funny."

7. Your affiant interviewed CONNOR MACCALISTER. After waiving her Miranda rights, she confessed to the stabbing. She said she was angry with life and she wanted to get back at someone. She had planned to go to Shaw's Supermarket and kill several random people. She wanted to target a small elderly female whom she knew wouldn't resist. She said she saw BOUDREAU in the parking lot and followed her into the store to the ice cream aisle where she grabbed her from behind and slit her throat. She only surrendered when the two males (WRIGHT and WILLIAMS) came to the aid of the victim and ordered MACCALISTER to the ground. She stated she's been planning this random attack for the past month.


