## TEMPORARY RESTRAINING ORDER

This case is before the Court on the application of Plaintiffs for a temporary restraining order. Having reviewed the application and the verified facts in the pleadings filed by Plaintiffs, and finding that irreparable injury will occur in the form of constitutional deprivations to the applicants if Defendant is not immediately restrained, the Court enters the following order:

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Defendant Demesia Padilla is temporarily restrained, until further order of the Court, from continuing performance of the New Mexico Taxation and Revenue Department's Residency Certification Program, including the in-person interviews of individuals who have been targeted by the Program, and from engaging in any efforts to continue the re-verification and/or cancellation of previously issued drivers' licenses and identification cards.
