NOTICE OF ADVICE OF RIGHT TO COUNSEL FOR ALL JUDICIAL PROCEEDINGS

TO THE PERSON CHARGED:

1. This paper charges you with committing a crime.
2. If you have been arrested and remain in custody, you have the right to have a judicial officer decide whether you should be released from jail until your trial.
3. If you have been served with a citation or summons directing you to appear before a judicial officer for a preliminary inquiry at a date and time designated or within five days of service if no time is designated, a judicial officer will advise you of your rights, the charges against you, and penalties. The preliminary inquiry will be cancelled if a lawyer has entered an appearance to represent you.
4. You have the right to have a lawyer.
5. A lawyer can be helpful to you by:
 - (A) explaining the charges in this paper;
 - (B) telling you the possible penalties;
 - (C) helping you at trial;
 - (D) helping you protect your constitutional rights; and
 - (E) helping you to get a fair penalty if convicted.
6. Even if you plan to plead guilty, a lawyer can be helpful.
7. If you are eligible, the Public Defender or a court-appointed attorney will represent you at any initial appearance before a judicial officer and at any proceeding under Rule 4-216.1 to review an order of a District Court commissioner regarding pretrial release. If you want a lawyer for any further proceeding, including trial, but do not have the money to hire one, the Public Defender may provide a lawyer for you. The court clerk will tell you how to contact the Public Defender.
8. If you want a lawyer but you cannot get one and the Public Defender will not provide one for you, contact the court clerk as soon as possible.
9. **DO NOT WAIT UNTIL THE DATE OF YOUR TRIAL TO GET A LAWYER.** If you do not have a lawyer before the trial date, you may have to go to trial without one.

NOTICE TO DEFENDANT

1. **MUST APPEAR** - If the offense with which you are charged is a 'MUST APPEAR' offense, you may not waive trial but are required to appear in court when notified. PLEASE NOTE THAT FAILURE TO APPEAR MAY RESULT IN A WARRANT FOR YOUR ARREST.

2. **PRESET FINE** - You must either pay the preset fine, request a waiver hearing, or request a trial date within 30 days after receipt of the citation/summons/warrant.

NOTE: If charged by citation, follow instructions on the citation. **IF CHARGED BY STATEMENT OF CHARGES (SUMMONS OR WARRANT), CHECK ONE OF THE FOLLOWING OPTIONS, SIGN AND DATE, AND MAIL THIS FORM, ALONG WITH A COPY OF THE STATEMENT OF CHARGES (SUMMONS OR WARRANT) TO THE ADDRESS SHOWN BELOW:**

OPTION #1:

Request a Waiver Hearing: I admit I committed the violation in this Statement of Charges, and I request a waiver hearing to explain the circumstances to a judge. I understand this is not a trial, the officer and witnesses will not be present, and my appearance in court is for sentencing only.

OPTION #3:

Request a trial date: I request a trial date for the violation(s) charged.

I, the undersigned, apply for a statement of charges and a summons or warrant which may lead to the arrest of the above named defendant because on or about Oct 4 & 5, 2015 at 630 W Bay Front Road Lothian, Anne Arundel County, Maryland 20711, the above named Defendant

did conspire to commit first degree murder of Anthony J. Anastasi Jr. and Jacquelyn I. Riggs.
(Concise statement of acts showing that there is probable cause to believe that a crime has been committed and that the Defendant has committed it.)

On October 5, 2015 at approximately 12:57pm, officers with the Anne Arundel County Police Department responded to 630 W Bay Front Road, Lothian, Anne Arundel County, Maryland 20711 for a complaint of a suicide. Ann Anastasi had called police reporting her husband, Anthony J. Anastasi Jr., had committed

suicide inside of the home. Responding officers discovered the body of Anthony J. Anastasi Jr. in the master bedroom of the residence deceased from an apparent gunshot wound to the upper body.

Ann Anastasi advised officers at the scene that the prior evening (10/04/15) she, Anastasi Jr., and Jacquelyn I. Riggs (who was living with them in the basement), had been in her (Ann's) and Anastasi's bedroom drinking alcohol and searching on a computer for a replacement vehicle for Riggs. Sometime between 10:00pm and 11:00pm Anastasi Jr. went into the basement of the residence to discuss the plans about Riggs' vehicle. While in the basement Anastasi Jr. and Riggs could be heard arguing before Anastasi Jr. came back upstairs to Ann Anastasi and Anastasi's bedroom. Once back in the bedroom Anastasi Jr. told Ann Anastasi not to go in the basement or to bother Riggs. Anastasi Jr. next instructed Ann Anastasi to get the kittens and for her to get out of their bedroom. Anastasi Jr. then locked the bedroom doors. Ann Anastasi then went and slept in an adjoining bedroom with two of their children.

Ann Anastasi advised the following morning (10/05/15) she got up and got their five children off to school. She then took Catherine Anastasi (one of the five children) to a dentist appointment and then to school. She then returned home where Sara Anastasi (13yoa daughter) was home sick from school. She and Sara Anastasi then went to the grocery store.

Ann Anastasi advised when they returned home from the grocery store she tried to wake Anastasi Jr. for a doctor appointment. After not being able to wake him she noticed a handgun next to him. She then called police.

After learning of Riggs officers checked the basement and found Jacquelyn I. Riggs deceased from apparent stab wounds. Investigators from the homicide unit were then summoned to the scene.

A search the 630 W Bay Front Road residence was obtained from Ann Anastasi. During the search, investigators discovered a Sig Saur .45 caliber handgun next to the body Anastasi Jr. There was also a single .380 shell casing found within close proximity of Anastasi Jr. However, no .380 handguns or additional .380 caliber ammuniton was found at the residence.

In the search of the residence regarding the body of Riggs, investigators were not able to locate an edged weapon that they believe was used to murder Riggs. There was no sign of forced entry to the residence or of an intruder entering the residence.


Ann Anastasi and her children to include Sara Anastasi, were interviewed at the homicide unit. It was determined the marriage between Ann Anastasi and Anastasi Jr. was fraught with conflict and domestic abuse. Historically Ann Anastasi, Riggs, and Anastasi Jr. were all sexual/romantic partners. However, the relationship between Ann Anastasi, Riggs, and Anastasi Jr. strained. Riggs and Anastasi were still involved in a sexual/romantic relationship. Ann Anastasi was not. During interviews with Ann Anastasi and Sara Anastasi their statement to investigators were found to inconsistent and misleading. Investigators specifically asked Ann Anastasi if she had disturbed the scene or discharged a firearm recently. Ann Anastasi advised that she had not.

Also during Ann Anastasi's interview gunshot residue samples were taken from her person and clothing. A forensic examination of the samples found gunshot residue on Ann Anastasi's person and clothing.

A forensic examination and analysis of the Sig Saur .45 caliber handgun found next to Anastasi Jr. and the .380 shell casing found in the master bedroom concluded that the handgun did not fire the shell casing. The

same examination concluded the projectile that was removed from Anastasi Jr.'s head was a .380 caliber and also found not to have been fired from the Sig Saur .45 caliber handgun. This would suggest that Anthony's death was not a suicide.

During this investigation historical cellular telephone records to include text messages for the dates of October 4th and 5th, 2015 were obtained for Ann Anastasi's known cellular telephone. A review of text messages found that on those dates there was communication with another phone/individual conspiring between the above defendant and juvenile Sara Anastasi discussing the specific exchange of a handgun, specific transportation to the crime scene, specific concealment of an individual on the property, and specific discussion of murder of two individuals.

A pathological exam was later conducted on both Anastasi Jr. and Riggs by the Office of the Chief Medical Examiner for the State of Maryland. The death of Riggs and Anastasi were both ruled homicides.

All events occurred in Anne Arundel County, Maryland except where noted above.
