OBJECTION TO MEDIA GUIDELINES ORDER

Pursuant to Rule 30 of the Rules of the Tennessee Supreme Court, WBIR-TV Channel 10 (hereafter "WBIR-TV"), by and through counsel, respectfully objects to the Media Guidelines Order (the "Order") entered by this Court on September 30, 2011. WBIR-TV objects on the basis that the Order was entered and served upon WBIR-TV, along with other local media outlets, without an evidentiary hearing in this matter, in contravention of Rule 30(D)(2) of the Rules of the Tennessee Supreme Court. In support of its Objection, WBIR-TV would show to the Court as follows:

1. WBIR-TV is a licensed television station in Knoxville, Tennessee, operating on Channel 10, WBIR-TV is a news media. WBIR-TV gathers and procures information for news broadcasting through its employees and agents.

2. Rule 30(A)(2) provides that the media's request for in-court media coverage must be made in writing not less than two business days before the proceeding is scheduled to being. WBIR-TV made its media request on February 10, 2011. A copy of WBIR-TV's Request for Coverage is attached hereto as <u>Exhibit 1</u> and Incorporated herein by reference as if set forth verbatim.

3. On Friday afternoon, September 30, 2011, WBIR-TV received, by facsimile, a copy of a Media Guidelines Order entered in this Court on September 30, 2011, at 1:55 p.m. The Media Guidelines Order specifically limits WBIR-TV's media coverage of the hearing in this cause, scheduled to begin on October 3, 2011.

4. Rule 30(D)(2) provides that the Court shall hold an evidentiary hearing before denying, limiting, suspending, or terminating media coverage. The burden of proof shall be on the party seeking limits on media coverage.

5. WBIR-TV asserts that the Order was entered in contravention to Rule 30 of the Rules of the Tennessee Supreme Court. Further, WBIR-TV asserts that there is no just cause to limit the media coverage in this case, and that the Order should be set aside.

WHEREFORE, WEIR-TV respectfully objects to the Media Guidelines Order entered in this case on September 30, 2011, and requests the Court to set aside that Order in its entirety, and conduct an evidentiary hearing prior to the entry of any further orders limiting media coverage.
