The Grand Jury charges:

FIRST COUNT:

Brandon Corley, also known as Brandon Andrews, within the District of Columbia, while armed with a firearm, purposely and with deliberate and premeditated malice, killed Leonard Bigelow by shooting him with a firearm on or about August 26, 2011, thereby causing injuries from which Leonard Bigelow died on or about August 26, 2011. (First Degree Murder While Armed (Premeditated), in violation of 22 D.C. Code, Sections 2101, 4502 (2001 ed.))

SECOND COUNT:

On or about August 26, 2011, within the District of Columbia, Brandon Corley, also known as Brandon Andrews, while armed with a firearm, assaulted Lacey Bigelow with intent to kill him. (Assault With Intent To Kill While Armed, in violation of 22 D.C. Code, Sections 401, 4502 (2001 ed.))

THIRD COUNT:

On or about August 26, 2011, within the District of Columbia, Brandon Corley, also known as Brandon Andrews, while armed with a firearm, assaulted Katina Bigelow with a dangerous weapon, that is, a firearm (Assault with a Dangerous Weapon, in violation of 22 D.C. Code, Sections 402, 4502 (2001 ed.))

FOURTH COUNT:

On or about August 22, 2011, within the District of Columbia, Brandon Corley, also known as Brandon Andrews, threatened to injure the person of Katina Bigelow. (Threatening To Injure/Kidnap a Person, in violation of 22 D.C. Code, Section 1810 (2001 ed.))

FIFTH COUNT:

On or about August 22, 2011, within the District of Columbia, Brandon Corley, also known as Brandon Andrews, threatened to injure the person of Katina Bigelow. (Threatening To Injure/Kidnap a Person, in violation of 22 D.C. Code, Section 1810 (2001 ed.))

SIXTH COUNT:

On or about August 26, 2011, within the District of Columbia, Brandon Corley, also known as Brandon Andrews, threatened to injure the person of Katina Bigelow. (Threatening To Injure/Kidnap a Person, in violation of 22 D.C. Code, Section 1810 (2001 ed.))

SEVENTH COUNT:

On or about August 26, 2011, within the District of Columbia, Brandon Corley, also known as Brandon Andrews, possessed a firearm while committing the crime of first degree murder while armed as set forth in the first count of this indictment. (Possession Of a Firearm During Crime Of Violence Or Dangerous Offense, in violation of 22 D.C. Code, Section 4504(b) (2001 ed.))

EIGHTH COUNT:

On or about August 26, 2011, within the District of Columbia, Brandon Corley, also known as Brandon Andrews, possessed a firearm while committing the crime of assault with intent to kill while armed as set forth in the second count of this indictment. (Possession Of a Firearm During Crime Of Violence Or Dangerous Offense, in violation of 22 D.C. Code, Section 4504(b) (2001 ed.))

NINTH COUNT:

On or about August 26, 2011, within the District of Columbia, Brandon Corley, also known as Brandon Andrews, possessed a firearm while committing the crime of assault with a deadly or dangerous weapon as set forth in the third count of this indictment. (Possession Of a Firearm During Crime Of Violence Or Dangerous Offense, in violation of 22 D.C. Code, Section 4504(b) (2001 ed.))

TENTH COUNT

On or about August 26, 2011, within the District of Columbia, Brandon Corley, also known as Brandon Andrews, previously having been convicted in any court of a crime of violence other than conspiracy punishable by imprisonment for a term exceeding one year, owned, kept, and had within his possession and control, a firearm. (Unlawful Possession of a Firearm, in violation of 22 D.C. Code, Section 4503(a)(1) (2001 ed.))
