On Saturday, April 28, 2012, at approximately 1340 hours, members of the Sixth District received a radio assignment for the report of a "shooting." Arriving on the scene, officers discovered the victim lying on the sidewalk by the bus stop suffering from gunshots wounds to the head and body. The decedent was unconscious and unresponsive. DCEMS Medic #27 transported the decedent to Prince Georges County Hospital, where he was pronounced dead at 1422 hours by Doctor Blair of the hospital staff. The remains of the decedent were transported to the Maryland Medical Examiner Office in Baltimore, MD, pending an autopsy.

On Sunday, April 29, 2012 Dr. Weedn of the Baltimore Chief Medical Examiner's Office performed an autopsy on the decedent. Dr. Weedn advised that the cause of death was multiple gunshots wounds and the manner of death was Homicide.

On Sunday, April 29, 2012 a District of Columbia Superior Court Arrest Warrant for Second Degree Murder While Armed was issued by Judge Jennifer Ditoro.

On Monday, April 30, 2012, the defendant (Dietrich Baker) was arrested at approximately 1445 hrs by members of the CARFTF inside of 3611 22nd St SE. The defendant (Dietrich Baker) was transported to the Homicide Branch located at 101 M St. SW, Washington D.C for processing.

The events and acts described above occurred primarily in the District of Columbia and were committed as described by defendant(s) listed in the case caption.

On Saturday, April 28, 2012, at approximately 1340 hours, members of the Sixth District received a radio assignment for the report of a "shooting." Arriving on the scene, officers discovered the victim lying on the sidewalk by the bus stop suffering from gunshots wounds to the head and body. The decedent was unconscious and unresponsive. DCEMS Medic #27 transported the decedent to Prince Georges County Hospital, where he was pronounced dead at 1422 hours by Doctor Blair of the hospital staff. The remains of the decedent were then transported to the Maryland Medical Examiner in Baltimore, MD, pending an autopsy.

On Saturday, April 28, 2012, the undersigned conducted an interview with Witness #1, who stated that IT observed the decedent approach the bus stop, located alongside of 776 Kenilworth Terrace, NE Washington, D.C. Witness #1 stated the decedent and the defendant spoke to each other and exchanged greetings. Witness #1 states that the defendant was in possession of a red backpack. Witness #1 stated that within seconds, the defendant produced a large handgun and started shooting at the decedent, striking him multiple times. The defendant then fled on foot towards the rear of 800 Kenilworth Ave, NE, Washington, D.C. which is across the street from the location of the shooting.

Video surveillance recorded the defendant running behind the rear of the building with a backpack draped around his neck. The video further showed that after an unsuccessful attempt to gain entry into the building, the defendant then fled from the rear of the building back towards the 700 block of Kenilworth Terrace NE. He then fled along the sidewalk into the 700 block of Kenilworth Terrace, NE. Video footage then revealed the same defendant who entered the rear of the building with a backpack was no longer in possession of the backpack as he fled down the street.

On Saturday, April 28, 2012, an officer who is assigned to patrol the community where the shooting occurred, was shown the video footage recorded from the rear of 800 Kenilworth Avenue, NE. After reviewing the footage, the officer positively identified the person in the video as being a subject that he had stopped the prior day and identified him as Dietrich Baker.

On Saturday, April 28, 2012, Witness #1 was shown a photo array that consisted of nine (9)

Witness#2 whose residence which overlooks the 700 block of Kenilworth Terrace, NE, reports that it observed the defendant shooting at the decedent while he (the decedent) was lying on ground. Witness #2 then observed the defendant run across the street to the rear of 800 Kenilworth Avenue, NE, and then toss a black bag into the dumpster. Witness #2 also reported to one of the first officer on the scene that the gun used in the shooting was in the trash dumpster in the rear of 800 Kenilworth Avenue NE.

A search of the area, resulted in the recovery a gray, red and black backpack that was later recovered from a trash dumpster, which was located in the rear of 800 Kenilworth Avenue, NE. Recovered from within the backpack were five live .357 rounds. Also recovered from the same trash dumpster was a Taurus Revolver, .357caliber, with five spent casings and one (1) live round inside of the chamber.

Based on the facts and circumstances, your affiant respectfully requests that a District of Columbia Superior Court Judge issue an arrest warrant for Dietrich Baker / AKA "Detrek Baker, charging him with Murder 2 While Armed.
