The Grand Jury charges:

FIRST COUNT:

Stephanie Lawson, within the District of Columbia, while armed with a dangerous weapon, that is a knife, purposely and with deliberate and premeditated malice killed Karen Jordan by stabbing her with a knife on or about August 27, 2011, thereby causing injuries from which Karen Jordan died on or about August 27, 2011. (First Degree Murder While Armed (Premeditated), in violation of 22 D.C. Code, Sections 2101, 4502 (2001 ed.))

SECOND COUNT:

On or about August 27, 2011, within the District of Columbia, Stephanie Lawson did carry, openly and concealed on or about her person, a dangerous weapon, capable of being so concealed, that is, a knife. (Carrying a Dangerous Weapon, in violation of 22 D.C. Code, Section 4504(a) (2001 ed.))

THIRD COUNT:

On or about August 27, 2011, within the District of Columbia, Stephanie Lawson did corruptly and by threat of force obstruct, impede or endeavor to obstruct and impede the due administration of justice in an official proceeding. (Obstructing Justice (Due Administration of Justice), in violation of 22 D.C. Code, Section 722 (a)(6) (2001 ed.))
