The Grand Jury charges:

FIRST COUNT:

Antonio D. Jones, within the District of Columbia, while armed with a firearm, purposely and with deliberate and premeditated malice killed Davon Gray by shooting him with a firearm on or about October 15, 2011, thereby causing injuries from which Davon Gray died on or about October 15, 2011. (First Degree Murder While Armed (Premeditated), in violation of 22 D.C. Code, Sections 2101, 4502 (2001 ed.))

SECOND COUNT:

On or about October 15, 2011, within the District of Columbia, Antonio D. Jones did possess a firearm while committing the crime of murder as set forth in the first count of this indictment. (Possession Of a Firearm During Crime Of Violence Or Dangerous Offense, in violation of 22 D.C. Code, Section 4504(b) (2001 ed.))

THIRD COUNT:

On or about October 15, 2011, within the District of Columbia, Antonio D. Jones, previously having been convicted of a felony or a violation of 22 D.C. Code, Section 4504(a) (2001 ed.), did carry, openly and concealed on or about his person, in a place other than his dwelling place, place of business or on other land possessed by him, a pistol, without a license issued pursuant to law. (Carrying a Pistol Without a License (Outside Home or Place of Business), in violation of 22 D.C. Code, Section 4504(a) (2001 ed.))

FOURTH COUNT:

On or about October 15, 2011, within the District of Columbia, Antonio D. Jones, previously having been convicted in any court of a crime punishable by imprisonment for a term exceeding one year, owned, kept and had within his possession and control, a firearm. (Unlawful Possession of a Firearm, in violation of 22 D.C. Code Section 4503(a)(1) (2001 ed.))
