GIVE BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF WHAT HAPPENED: The offense occurred on 7/8/2012 at approximately 12:04 am in the 1700 block of Galen St SE in Washington DC. Units from the Seventh District were dispatched to investigate the report of a shooting. Upon arrival they observed the decedent later identified as Davon Brown lying on the South sidewalk across from 1714 Galen St. SE. The decedent, who was unconscious and unresponsive, was suffering from multiple gunshot wounds. A second gunshot victim was located in the hallway of 2312 Green St SE. 2312 Green St. SE is an apartment building which has a rear door that leads out to the 1700 block of Galen St. SE. The second victim was also suffering from multiple gunshot wounds. DCFEMS responded to the scene and determined the decedent had no signs of life. The decedent remained on the scene and was subsequently transported to the Office of the Chief Medical Examiner pending pronouncement of death and autopsy. The second victim was transported to the hospital for treatment. On 7/8/12 the decedent was officially pronounced deceased. An autopsy was conducted. The cause of death was determined to be a gunshot wound to the chest. The manner was determined to be homicide. As a result of the subsequent investigation the defendant, JASHUA JOHNSON, a black male with a PDID of 653-451, was identified as the perpetrator of the offense.

On 7/9/12 a witness referred hereafter as W1, was located and interviewed. W1 reported that on the night in question IT was in the 1700 block of Galen St SE. W1 observed a black male suspect pushing the second gunshot victim down the street. W1 then saw a subject known to IT as "Josh" appear from behind the two parties and produce a black handgun. W1 reported that "Josh" then began shooting at the second gunshot victim. W1 observed the second gunshot victim flee into 2312 GREEN St SE with "Josh" in pursuit.

W1 went on to note that moments before the shooting, IT observed the decedent walking towards 2308 Green St SE. 2308 Green St SE is another apartment building which also has a rear door that leads out to the 1700 block of Galen St. SE and sits across from 1714 Galen St. SE. W1 noted that "Josh" was shooting in the direction of where the decedent was walking. W1 reported that "Josh" was the only person IT observed firing a weapon. After the shooting W1 observed that the decedent had been shot at the location where IT had seen him moments before the shooting, and where the police ended up finding the decedent's body.

During the interview W1 described Def. JOHNSON as a black male, short with dread-styled hair. "Josh" was known by W1 to live in the 1700 block of Galen St SE and was affiliated with the BARRY FARMS neighborhood. Based on the information provided, Def. JOHNSON was identified as a person of interest. Def. JOHNSON is described as a black male, approximately 5'3 in height, with dark complexion and dreads. Def. JOHNSON also has had previous contacts with law enforcement in the Barry Farms area.

A sequential photo array was then compiled of 9 photos to include that of Def. JOHNSON. Upon viewing the array W1 identified Def. JOHNSON as the person known to IT as "Josh" and the person that was shooting on the night in question.

It should also be noted that the Shotspotter system detected the sounds of gunshots at approximately 12:02AM in the 1700 block of Galen St SE on the night in question. The undersigned had an opportunity to listen to the recording of that event. The Shotspotter detected approximately 8 gunshots from what sounded like one weapon.

A second witness, referred to hereafter as W2 was located and interviewed. W2 reported that on the night in question IT was located inside 2312 Green St SE. W2 advised that IT heard what IT believed to be a gunshot coming from outside of 2312 Green St SE. There was a brief pause. Seconds later W2 heard gunshots again. W2 reported that the sounds of gunshots were then coming from inside of 2312 Green St SE, thereby corroborating the account of W1 as to the circumstances of the shooting.

Based on the aforementioned facts and circumstances, including the observations of W1 and ITS identification of JASHUA JOHNSON as the person shooting at the second gunshot victim and in the direction of the decedent, along with the supporting observations of W2 and the information provided by the Shotspotter system, your Affiant respectfully submits that probable cause exists to believe that JASHUA JOHNSON committed the murder of Davon Brown and the shooting of the second gunshot victim. Your Affiant respectfully requests that a DC Superior Court arrest warrant be issued for the defendant identified as JASHUA JOHNSON, a black male with a PDID of 653-451.




