On December 6, 2010 at approximately 1030 hours, Chief William Hogan and I conducted a walk-through inspection of the Property Control Area. We met and spoke with Property Control Manager Lee Smith. The entire area was neat, clean, and well organized.

Due to the amount of evidence and property being submitted and processed on a regular basis, space continues to be a great need for the Property and Evidence Section. Currently the Property and Evidence Section is utilizing on-site non-attached storage containers. The storage containers are alarmed and wired for electricity and are currently in use for non-sensitive items.

On a weekly basis Property Control continues to deliver to the NC State Bureau of Investigation (SBI) Drug Lab 10-20 drug cases for drug analysis as well as delivering to NC Division of Motor Vehicles all of the registration tags that are seized by our officers. These items are time sensitive thus requiring immediate attention. All other items of evidence and property are processed accordingly. The returning of property to the rightful owner(s) is being done as well on a continuous and on-going basis.
