A review on 4/5/61 by IC [redacted] of the military service records on file at the General Services Administration, Military Personnel Records Center, for RICHARD MASATO AOKI, Serial Number 19 572 630, indicated that he enlisted in the U.S. Army Reserve on 11/15/56, and entered on active duty in the U.S. Army for six months active duty training on 2/3/57 at Oakland, Calif.

He was honorably released from active duty and transferred to the U.S. Army Reserve to complete his military obligation under the Universal Military Training and Service Act on 8/2/57 as a Private at Fort Ord, Calif.

The terminal date of his reserve obligation was shown as 11/14/64.

No additional information concerning his reserve service was shown. He had no foreign service and was awarded no medals, decorations, or citations.

His character and efficiency ratings were not shown, and there is no record of courts-martial or absence without official leave. The above information is furnished for the Bureau's information. 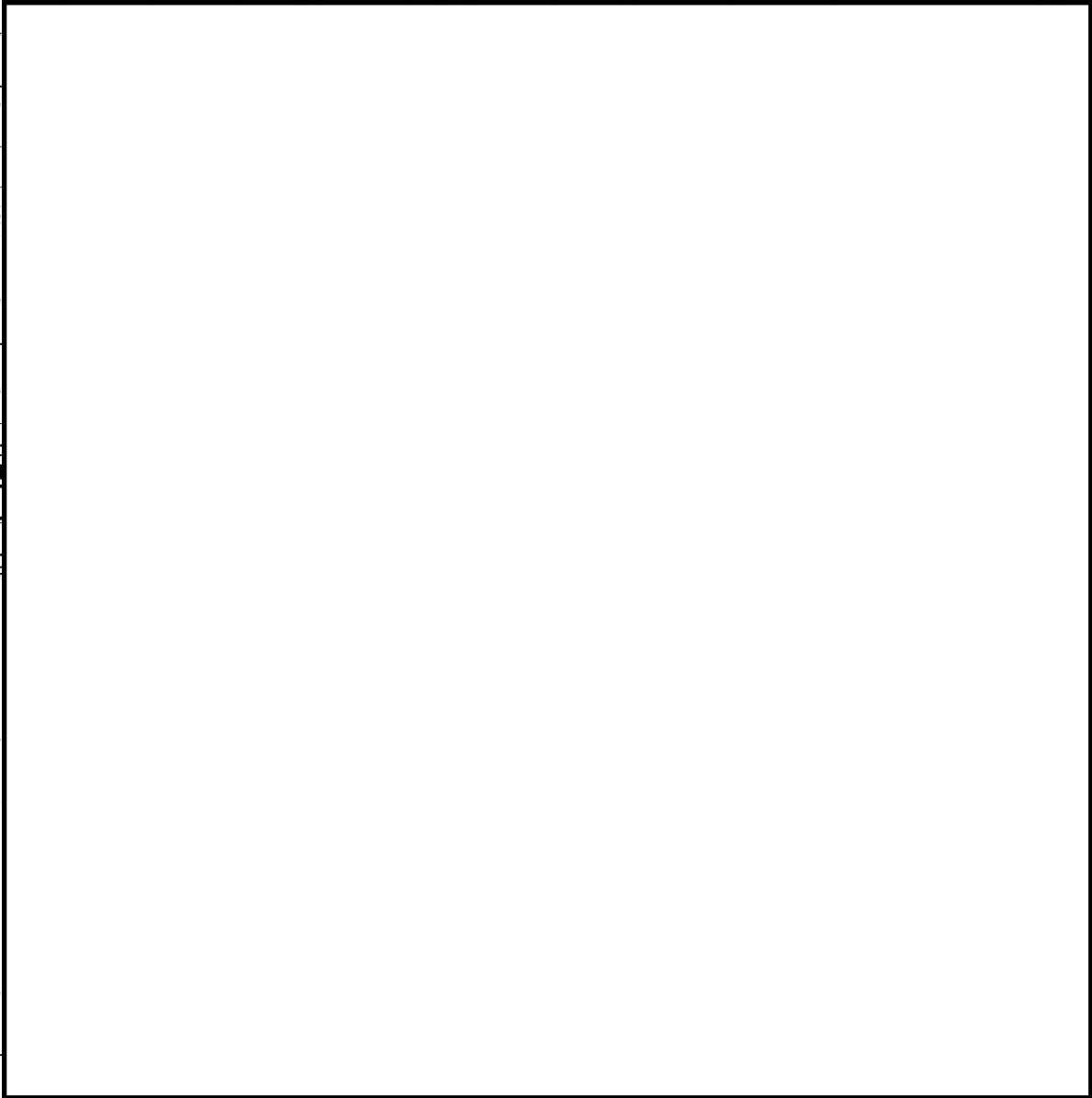

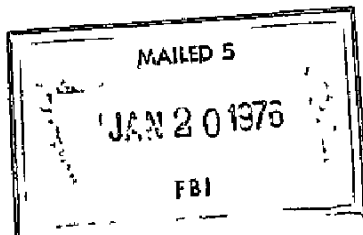

When contacted 9/30/77, source advised that he desired to discontinue seeking information for the FBI because he believed that this was inconsistent with his present career and objectives as a student counselor and instructor at a junior college in Oakland, California.

Source advised that he is not willing to testify in open court or before administrative hearing boards if such testimony would reveal his past connection with the FBI. This would alienate him from associates and friends and would cause him great trouble in his relationships with students as a student counselor.
