Dear Sir/Madam,

Mr. Emanuel Kahsai was admitted to the forensic unit of the Southern Alberta Forensic Psychiatry Centre (SAFPC) for the purpose of determining his fitness to stand trial. Mr. Kahsai has been charged with two counts of First Degree Murder, contrary to Section 235(1).

Mr. Kahsai was admitted at the SAFPC on July 7, 2016. Whilst at the unit, he was interviewed by myself and by the other members of the assessment team. Mr. Kahsai's psychosocial assessment was conducted by [REDACTED] a social worker, and his psychological assessment was completed by [REDACTED] a psychologist. I have had an opportunity to review all the materials submitted to my attention by the Crown Prosecutor's Office. In addition, I have reviewed Alberta Health Services file information, as well as progress notes from Mr. Kahsai's medical file from the Calgary Remand Centre (CRC). I also reviewed the information provided on my request by CRC psychologists, [REDACTED] and [REDACTED]. In addition, some collateral information was obtained by [REDACTED] from [REDACTED] and [REDACTED]. Mr. Kahsai's mother's friends; [REDACTED] family friend; [REDACTED] Mr. Kahsai's former girlfriend; [REDACTED] Mr. Kahsai's former employer; and [REDACTED] Calgary North Probation.

On our request [REDACTED] attempted to contact [REDACTED], Mr. Kahsai's father, and [REDACTED] Mr. Kahsai's paternal aunt, but they both did not return phone calls.

Mr. Kahsai was aware of the purpose of the assessment, and that the report would be sent to court.

RELEVANT HISTORY:


DIAGNOSIS AND LEGAL ISSUES:

Based on the results of the current assessment, it is my opinion that Mr. Khsai's mental difficulties can best be categorized as **Alcohol and Polysubstance Abuse Disorder**. He also presents as an individual with **prominent traits of Antisocial Personality Disorder**.

I should indicate that during the current forensic psychiatric assessment Mr. Khsai demonstrated **intentional production of false multiple psychological symptoms** (such as being brainwashed and affected by telepathy and telekinesis; feeling that his brain is affected through light, as well as through radio and TV; experiencing jerky movements, and others), **which in this case clearly reflect his objective to be perceived as severely mentally disordered individual**. This type of Mr. Khsai's behaviours should be qualified as **malingering**.

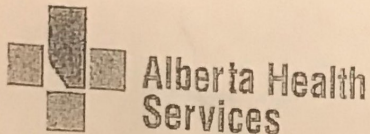


