GIVE BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF WHAT HAPPENED:											

On Sunday, September 30th, 2012, at approximately 2:29 a.m., members of the Fourth Police District received a report of a shooting in the 7400 block of Georgia Ave, N.W., Washington D.C. Upon their arrival members located a black male later identified as Lamar Fonville, 29 years old, unconscious and unresponsive, in front of 7436 Georgia Avenue Northwest, suffering from at least one apparent gunshot wound to the head.

Members from the District of Columbia Fire Department responded to the scene and determined that Lamar Fonville, hereinafter the decedent, would not be transported to an area hospital and he remained on the scene until transported to the Office of the Chief Medical Examiner for the District of Columbia.

On Sunday, September 30, 2012, Dr. Angellee Chen of the Office of Chief Medical Examiner conducted an autopsy on the decedent and determined the cause of death was a single gunshot wound of the head and the manner of death was ruled a homicide.

During the course of this investigation a witness was located and interviewed for the purpose of this investigation. W-1 initially denied having knowledge concerning the murder. Upon further interview, W-1 reported that on the night of the shooting "IT" and the decedent were in the area of stairs that were adjacent to the front side of 7436 Georgia Avenue, Northwest, Washington D.C., when "IT" observed the suspect and an unknown black male walking northbound in the 7400 block of Georgia Avenue, Northwest, Washington, DC. The suspect and the unknown black male spoke to the decedent. The suspect gave the decedent "dap" and began a conversation. The decedent introduced the suspect as "Eric:" The decedent further stated that he and the suspect grew up together. The suspect stated that he was going to smoke a joint and the suspect and the unknown black male continued walking northbound on Georgia Avenue, NW where they met a third individual. W-1 described the suspect as 5'9 or 5'10, 160-175 lbs, light complexion, bald, clean shaven, maybe 29 or 30 years of age, possibly wearing a white shirt and jeans, and lives in a house on one of the streets in the area behind the PNC bank on Georgia Avenue, NW. W-1 stated that IT has seen the suspect riding in a white car in the past.

Moments later, the suspect returned by himself and began another conversation with the decedent. According to W-1, the conversation between the decedent and the suspect appeared to be non-hostile and there were no arguments. Without provocation, W-1 observed the suspect pull from his waistband a firearm and fire multiple rounds at the decedent. W-1 ran and observed the suspect fleeing. The suspect dropped the firearm, turned and picked it up, and ran to a vehicle which the suspect entered. The vehicle then fled the area. W-1 stated that IT believed the suspect was high because the suspect was smoking a joint or something.

W-1 was shown a nine-picture photo spread of individuals whose first name was or contained the name "Eric" and were from PSA 401. W-1 individually observed each photograph and stated, "No one in here." A ninepicture photo array was shown to W-1. W-1 viewed the array and pointed to number six, stating, the dude looks like this one but he is lighter, or words to that effect. W-1 requested to see larger pictures of the individuals depicted in the array. The same photos were presented to W-1 individually, but photo number six, was placed as number five in the group of photos. W-1 placed photo number five aside and continued to view the rest of the photos. Once viewing the rest of the photos, W-1 held photograph number 5 and stated "this one here looks almost close like him. It could be him. His name Eric, that looks just like him," or words to that effect. On October 2, 2012, law enforcement developed the name Arik Sims, DOB: 7/9/1988, PDID: 553-270 as a potential suspect. Homicide detectives prepared a nine-picture photo array which contained a MPDC photograph of Arik Sims, PDID: 553-270 in position #4. Homicide detectives showed W-1 this array. W-1 immediately chose picture number four, stating "that's him." W-1 was asked, "What is it about number four, what did number four do?" W-1 replied "he shot Lamar". W-1 was then asked "Did you see number four shoot Lamar?" W-1 replied "Yeah, I was right there." The person W-1 identified as the shooter in this case is Arik Sims, black male with a date of birth of 7-9-88 and PDID # 553-270, residing at Washington D.C.

Based upon the above facts and circumstances, your affiant respectfully request that a Judge of the District of Columbia, Superior Court issue an arrest warrant for Arik Sims, DOB: 7/9/1988, and PDID 553-270 for First Degree Murder while Armed.
