Suspects

A suspect is a person of interest whom investigators believe to have culpability in the commission of an offence(s) based on the evidence. (Major Case Management System (MCMS) Definition)

A suspect is a person(s) of interest whom investigators believe to have culpability in the commission of an offence or a conspiracy to commit offence(s) based on the intelligence or evidence received and processed.

Example: A person would be considered a “suspect” if investigators believe, on the basis of intelligence/evidence, that that individual has culpability in the commission of an offence, or in a conspiracy to commit an offence related to the 2010 G8-G20. This may include a mischief, a personation, an assault, or any criminal offence.
