The Grand Jury charges:

### FIRST COUNT:

On or about January 3, 2012, within the District of Columbia, David T. Robinson, also known as Two Ty, did carry, openly or concealed on or about his person, in a place other than his dwelling place, place of business or on other land possessed by any of them, a pistol, without a license issued pursuant to law. (Carrying a Pistol Without a License (Outside Home or Place of Business), in violation of 22 D.C. Code, Section 4504(a) (2001 ed.))

# SECOND COUNT:

On or about January 3, 2012, within the District of Columbia, David T. Robinson, also known as Two Ty, did possess a firearm without being the holder of a valid registration certificate. (Possession of Unregistered Firearm, in violation of 7 D.C. Code, Section 2502.01(a) (2001 ed.))

## THIRD COUNT:

On or about January 3, 2012, within the District of Columbia, David T. Robinson, also known as Two Ty, did possess ammunition without being the holder of a valid registration certificate for a firearm. (Unlawful Possession of Ammunition, in violation of 7 D.C. Code, Section 2506.01(3) (2001 ed.))
