The Grand Jury charges:

FIRST COUNT:

Donzell Butler, within the District of Columbia, while armed with a dangerous weapon, that is a knife, and with the intent to kill another and to inflict serious bodily injury on another and with a conscious disregard of an extreme risk of death or serious bodily injury to another, caused the death of Charles Anthony Scott, Jr., by stabbing him with a knife on or about July 7, 2012, thereby causing injuries from which Charles Anthony Scott, Jr. died on or about July 7, 2012. (Second Degree Murder While Armed, in violation of 22 D.C. Code, Sections 2103, 4502 (2001 ed.))

SECOND COUNT:

On or about July 7, 2012, within the District of Columbia, Donzell Butler, while armed with a dangerous weapon, that is a knife, knowingly and purposely caused serious bodily injury to Kevin Reeves, or under circumstances manifesting extreme indifference to human life, Donzell Butler intentionally and knowingly engaged in conduct which created a grave risk of serious bodily injury to Kevin Reeves, and thereby caused serious bodily injury to Kevin Reeves. (Aggravated Assault While Armed, in violation of 22 D.C. Code, Section 404.01, 4502 (2001 ed.))

THIRD COUNT:

On or about July 7, 2012, within the District of Columbia, Donzell Butler assaulted Kevin Reeves with a dangerous weapon, that is, a knife. (Assault with a Dangerous Weapon, in violation of 22 D.C. Code, Section 402 (2001 ed.))

FOURTH COUNT:

On or about July 7, 2012 within the District of Columbia, Donzell Butler did carry, openly and concealed on or about his person, a dangerous weapon capable of being so concealed, that is, a knife. (Carrying a Dangerous Weapon, in violation of 22 D.C. Code, Section 4504(a) (2001 ed.))
