The Grand Jury charges:

FIRST COUNT:

Joshua Johnson, also known as Jashua Johnson, within the District of Columbia, while armed with a firearm, purposely and with deliberate and premeditated malice, killed Davon Brown by shooting him with a firearm on or about July 8, 2012, thereby causing injuries from which Davon Brown died on or about July 8, 2012. (First Degree Murder While Armed (Premeditated), in violation of 22 D.C. Code, Sections 2101, 4502 (2001 ed.))

SECOND COUNT:

On or about July 8, 2012, within the District of Columbia, Joshua Johnson, also known as Jashua Johnson, did possess a firearm while committing the crime of murder as set forth in the first count of this indictment. (Possession Of a Firearm During Crime Of Violence Or Dangerous Offense, in violation of 22 D.C. Code, Section 4504(b) (2001 ed.))

THIRD COUNT:

On or about July 8, 2012, within the District of Columbia, Joshua Johnson, also known as Jashua Johnson, while armed with a firearm, assaulted Jahi Marshall with intent to kill him. (Assault With Intent To Kill While Armed, in violation of 22 D.C. Code, Sections 401, 4502 (2001 ed.))

FOURTH COUNT:

On or about July 8, 2012, within the District of Columbia, Joshua Johnson, also known as Jashua Johnson, did possess a firearm while committing the crime of assault with intent to kill as set forth in the third count of this indictment. (Possession Of a Firearm During Crime Of Violence Or Dangerous Offense, in violation of 22 D.C. Code, Section 4504(b) (2001 ed.))

FIFTH COUNT:

On or about July 8, 2012, within the District of Columbia, Joshua Johnson, also known as Jashua Johnson, while armed with a firearm, knowingly and purposely caused serious bodily injury to Jahi Marshall, or under circumstances manifesting extreme indifference to human life intentionally and knowingly engaged in conduct which created a grave risk of serious bodily injury to Jahi Marshall, and thereby caused serious bodily injury to Jahi Marshall. (Aggravated Assault While Armed, in violation of 22 D.C. Code, Section 404.01, 4502 (2001 ed.))

SIXTH COUNT:

On or about July 8, 2012, within the District of Columbia, Joshua Johnson, also known as Jashua Johnson, did possess a firearm while committing the crime of aggravated assault while armed as set forth in the fifth count of this indictment. (Possession Of a Firearm During Crime Of Violence Or Dangerous Offense, in violation of 22 D.C. Code, Section 4504(b) (2001 ed.))

SEVENTH COUNT:

On or about July 8, 2012, within the District of Columbia, Joshua Johnson, also known as Jashua Johnson, assaulted Marcus Eggleston with a dangerous weapon, that is, a firearm. (Assault with a Dangerous Weapon, in violation of 22 D.C. Code, Section 402 (2001 ed.))

EIGHTH COUNT:

On or about July 8, 2012, within the District of Columbia, Joshua Johnson, also known as Jashua Johnson did possess a firearm while committing the crime of assault with a dangerous weapon as set forth in the seventh count of this indictment. (Possession Of a Firearm During Crime Of Violence Or Dangerous Offense, in violation of 22 D.C. Code, Section 4504(b) (2001 ed.))

NINTH COUNT:

On or about July 8, 2012, within the District of Columbia, Joshua Johnson, also known as Jashua Johnson, assaulted Terrence Green with a dangerous weapon, that is, a firearm. (Assault with a Dangerous Weapon, in violation of 22 D.C. Code, Section 402 (2001 ed.))

TENTH COUNT:

On or about July 8, 2012, within the District of Columbia, Joshua Johnson, also known as Jashua Johnson, did possess a firearm while committing the crime of assault with a dangerous weapon as set forth in the ninth count of this indictment. (Possession Of a Firearm During Crime Of Violence Or Dangerous Offense, in violation of 22 D.C. Code, Section 4504(b) (2001 ed.))

ELEVENTH COUNT:

On or about July 8, 2012, within the District of Columbia, Joshua Johnson, also known as Jashua Johnson, did carry, openly and concealed on or about his person, in a place other than his dwelling place, place of business or on other land possessed by him, a pistol. (Carrying a Pistol (Outside Home or Place of Business), in violation of the Firearms Emergency Amendment Act of 2012, to be codified at 22 D.C. Code, Section 4504(a) (2001 ed.))
