GIVE BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF WHAT HAPPENED:												

On Thursday, March 14, 2013, at approximately 2340 hours, members of the Sixth District were dispatched to the 1000 block of 44th Street, Northeast, Washington DC for a report of a shooting. Officers arrived on the scene and found the decedent, who was later identified as Akinwole Olu Williams, lying face down on the ground in front of 10 44th Street Northeast, Washington DC suffering from an apparent gunshot wound to the chest. The decedent was transported from the scene by DCFD Medic 27 to a local hospital and pronounced dead at 0020 hour. The decedent's remains were transported to the Maryland State Medical Examiner's Office pending an autopsy. On Friday, March 15, 2013, an autopsy was conducted on the decedent's remains. The cause of death was ruled a gunshot wound to the center of chest with multiple pellets consistent with being shot with a shotgun, and the manner of death was Homicide.

During the preliminary investigation, Metropolitan Police Department Electronic Surveillance Unit recovered area surveillance footage from the night of the homicide. At 2332 hours, the decedent is depicted walking alone westbound in the 4400 block of Lee Street Northeast, Washington DC. Your affiant knows from investigation that the decedent was headed to the 1000 block of 44th Street, Northeast which is one block away. At 2333 hours, several individuals appear in the same 4400 block of Lee Street Northeast walking behind the decedent in the same westbound direction. Two individuals are walking at a fast pace. One of these two who are walking at a face pace point in the direction of a pathway that is a shortcut to the 1000 block of 44th Street, NE. Then, both individuals quickly head to the pathway. The remaining individuals are depicted walking toward the same pathway. After entering the pathway, the camera view loses sight of the several individuals. Moments later, the individuals that entered the path that is a shortcut to the 1000 block of 44th Street, NE are depicted running from the direction of the 1000 block of 44th Street to Lee Street in an eastbound direction.

A witness, hereinafter referred to as W1 was located. W1 stated that the night of the murder IT observed three individuals standing alongside 1063 44th Street, NE. IT heard D-1 say to D-2 and D-3, I'm going to rob him, or words to that effect. D-1, D-2, and D-3 then walked to the front of 1063 44th Street, NE where W-1 observed the

decedent attempting to enter the front door of the building. W-1 described the decedent as wearing glasses, dressed in a suit, and carrying a white bag. D-1, D-2, and D-3 walked past the decedent who was at the front door of the building then doubled-back standing within feet of the decedent and facing him. D-1 moved closer towards the decedent while pointing a shotgun at him. D-1 ordered the decedent to hand over his property. W1 stated that the decedent pushed the shotgun away and refused D-1's order. W-1 stated that IT observed the decedent walk towards D-1. W-1 stated that within seconds, IT heard one gunshot and observed the decedent holding his chest then collapsing to the ground. W-1 subsequently observed D-1, D-2, and D-3 fleeing on foot in the 4400 block of Lee Street, NE. W-1 described the shotgun as brown in color with both the butt and barrel sawed-off with tape on the butt of the shotgun.

Through your affiant's investigation, Deandre Shaheed, B/M, DOB: 12/19/1994, PDID #645-052 was identified as a possible suspect. W1 was shown a nine-picture photo array containing a MPDC photograph of Deandre Shaheed, B/M, DOB: 12/19/1994, PDID #645-052. W1 viewed the photo array and immediately identified Deandre Shaheed, B/M, DOB: 12/19/1994, PDID #645-052 as a participant in the robbery murder of the decedent. W1 identified him as the person who was armed with the shotgun and who shot the decedent.

Within weeks of the murder, Floyd Neal, DOB: 12/26/1992, and PDID # 637-361 was arrested for carrying a sawed-off shotgun. Both the barrel and butt were sawed-off with tape on the butt of the gun. Subsequently, W-1 was shown an MPDC single photo depicting Floyd Neal, DOB: 12/26/1992, and PDID # 637-361. W-1 positively identified the person depicted as one of the three individuals alongside 1063 44th Street NE and who IT observed approach the decedent when Deandre Shaheed stated I'm going to rob him, or words to that effect.

Through your affiant's investigation, Lafeyette Robinson, B/M, DOB: 07/26/1993, and PDID # 664-668 was developed as the possible third suspect. Through investigation, your affiant learned that Floyd Neal and Lafeyette Robinson are cousins. Further, your affiant learned through investigation that Lafeyette Robinson and Deandre Shaheed are close associates or friends. Your affiant showed W1 a single photo of Lafeyette Robinson, B/M, DOB: 07/26/1993, and PDID # 664-668. W-1 positively identified him as the third person who IT saw alongside 1063 44th Street NE and who IT observed approach the decedent when Deandre Shaheed stated I'm going to rob him, or words to that effect.

Early in this investigation Sixth District Officers were shown the surveillance video footage from the 4400 block of Lee Street Northeast, Washington DC. Officers identified three of the several individuals depicted as individuals other than Deandre Shaheed, Floyd Neal, and Lafeyette Robinson. The officers's identifications were not based on facial recognition because of the quality of the video. Rather, their identifications were based on general physical appearance, mannerisms, and walk.

Based on the aforementioned facts and circumstances, your affiant believes that probable cause exist to believe that Deandre Shaeed, DOB: 12/19/1994, committed this offense and prays that a D.C. Superior Court Arrest Warrant be issued for the defendant.
