On Wednesday, August 21, 2013, at 1852 hours, Seventh District Officers responded to the 4200 block of 4th Street, S.E., for the report of multiple gunshots. Arriving on the scene, officers discovered the victim lying on the walkway in front of 4208 4th Street, S.E. The decedent, who was later identified as Timothy Dawkins, was lying face down on the walkway. The decedent was unconscious and unresponsive. DCFD Engine #33 & Medic #33 examined the decedent and determined there were no signs of life. The decedent was not transported to the hospital. Carolina Diaz & Kathy Kim, OCME, responded to the scene and examined the remains. Carolina Diaz, MLI, pronounced the decedent at 2154 hours.

During the preliminary investigation, video surveillance of the apartment complex was viewed by your affiant. The video shows two males appearing to come from the area in front of apartment building 4202 4th Street, Southeast; one of the males (herein referred to as first male subject) is shown shooting in the direction of a male subject wearing a green shirt (herein referred to as second male subject) and the decedent. The gun that the first male subject is seen holding appears to have an extended clip, which would make it capable of firing a higher number of rounds than a conventionally configured firearm. Additional video captures the first male subject pursuing the second male subject as the two subjects exchange gunfire; in the course of the gun battle the decedent is shown falling face first on the sidewalk as he is running away from the gunfire. Video shows the second male subject making his escape by running south towards the rear of the apartment complex. Moments after the shooting stops, video shows the first male subject, with the male that he was first seen with, running back towards the 4202 building, with the first male subject actually entering the apartment building. From viewing currently available video surveillance, it is impossible to tell which subject shot or drew his weapon first. According to the surveillance video, at the time the decedent appears to be shot, the first male subject was the only person shooting in the decedent's direction.

When police and fire services arrived, the decedent was observed in the same position where the video shows him falling. The decedent was not found to be armed by police or fire services, nor does the decedent appear on the above-described video to ever point, brandish or hold a weapon. Police processing the scene recovered more than thirty-five (35) items of ballistics evidence along the route where the first male subject and second male subject exchanged gunfire. These items of ballistic evidence were spread out over a distance of at least 100

feet and the number and location of the items is consistent with an extended gun battle involving at least one firearm with expanded capacity.

A witness, herein referred to as W1, is a sworn police officer of the Metropolitan Police Department, Seventh District. W1 stated that as IT arrived on the scene, within five minutes of the shooting, IT observed a subject known to IT as Todd Green walking through the driveway and parking lot of 4209 4th Street, Southeast along with another subject. Since 2011, W1 has worked extensively in the area where the shooting occurred and in addition has worked 24 hours per week for the apartment complex of which the above-described buildings are a part. has seen Green on numerous occasions during that period, and has had multiple personal interactions with him including serving a barring notice on him. W1 has also seen the subject with whom Green was walking on numerous occasions during that period, and has had multiple personal interactions with him. W1 immediately recognized Green and noted the clothing he was wearing, as well as the clothing that the other subject was wearing. A short time later, W1 reviewed the video described above. W1 viewed the person who is described aboveas the first male subject and identified that person as the same person IT observed walking through the driveway of 4209 4th Street, Southeast when IT arrived on the scene, and stated that he was wearing the same clothing in the video that IT had observed him wearing in the parking lot. W1 identified that person (herein referredto as the first male subject) as Todd Green, DOB 2/25/1991, PDID# 555-160. After viewing the video and making the observations discussed here, W1 broadcast a lookout for Todd Green over a police radio channel to alert members of the Seventh District.

A check of Metropolitan Police Department data revealed the following identifying information for Todd Green: DOB 2/25/1991, PDID# 555-160, with last known address of 3156 Stanton Road, Southeast.

On August 23, 2013, W1 and police officers of the Seventh District observed defendant Todd Green standing with two other male subjects in the park which is located in the 4500 block of Livingston Road, Southeast. W1 and the officers attempted to make contact with the defendant to verify his identity and as they approached the defendant he began to run. A foot chase ensued with the suspect being apprehended moments later by Officer Little. W1 made a positive identification of the defendant as the person he saw on August 21, 2013 and in
