Gary,

I received application record information from the applicator this morning. The record indicates glyphosate was the active ingredient applied on three sites on 16 October. The actual product was Roundup Original EPA Reg #524-445. Two of the sites applied were near the Cedar Valley area where many of the complainants live and the third site is east of Gold Beach proper. Times of the applications are consistent with the complainant's reports. The two apps near Cedar Valley took place between 1024 and 1240 hours. The site near Gold Beach was between 1630 and 1526 hours.

Glyphosate was one of the active ingredients reported to the complainants when they asked what was applied.

Hi Mike,

I have just talked 20 minutes with another victim on the Oct 16, 2013 return flight over Cedar Valley. Tomorrow, I will speak with her mother, another victim.

Please get the spray information from the pilot. We need the Portland lab to start their work asap looking for the exact ingredients.

Please consider using a court order to seize the pilot's books in order to learn what was sprayed on October 16th.

RE: Case Number: 140147 involving the yellow helicopter that released spray on residents below on a return flight into Cedar Valley

Have you or your staff been able to contact Steve Owens? We are still in urgent need to learn 1) the names of the spray ingredients sprayed on timberlands on October 16, 2013, 2) the ownership of the lands sprayed, and 3) the specific map and tax numbers of the timberlands sprayed?

Please specify in your conversation with Mr. Owens that this inquiry is about the spraying mission after he flew southeasterly over Ponderosa Drive/Cedar Valley Road in Cedar Valley, a residential area which is approximately three miles north of the Rogue River. The approximate time of the flights was between noon and 2:00 pm. His apparent destination was part of the Lobster Creek drainage or perhaps beyond across the Rogue River.

Evidently, Mr. Owens flew another mission in or around Grizzly Mt. that same day, so we, the residents of Ponderosa Drive/Cedar Valley Road, don't need information on that spraying mission.

Also, if at possible, could you also ask Mr. Owens why he flew over Cedar Valley to reach his spray targets that day? This is a question that many residents have been asking.
