I'm well aware that ODA has steps in place to protect investigative results (so that any violations found hold up in administrative court). But the lack of information is starting to create its own problems which I don't think will be helpful in the end.

Can you please tell me the <u>preliminary</u> findings as to what the EPA Reg. No., Al's and tank mix products are?

In relating those, I will convey that those are unconfirmed/unofficial at this point. If you don't have preliminary results back, please let me know when you expect to have the results back.
