- Site has experienced **22 fatalities** in the last **30 years**.
- **2 People have Died** on our Site this Year.
- **32 Osha Injuries** have occurred on-site this year.
- We experienced **3 Near Fatal Injuries** in 2003
 - Bob McEuen's Burn
 - Drilling into Live Hydrogen Line
 - Cutting into Live 13.8kV Cable

- Worked on AU2 TAR in May 2004

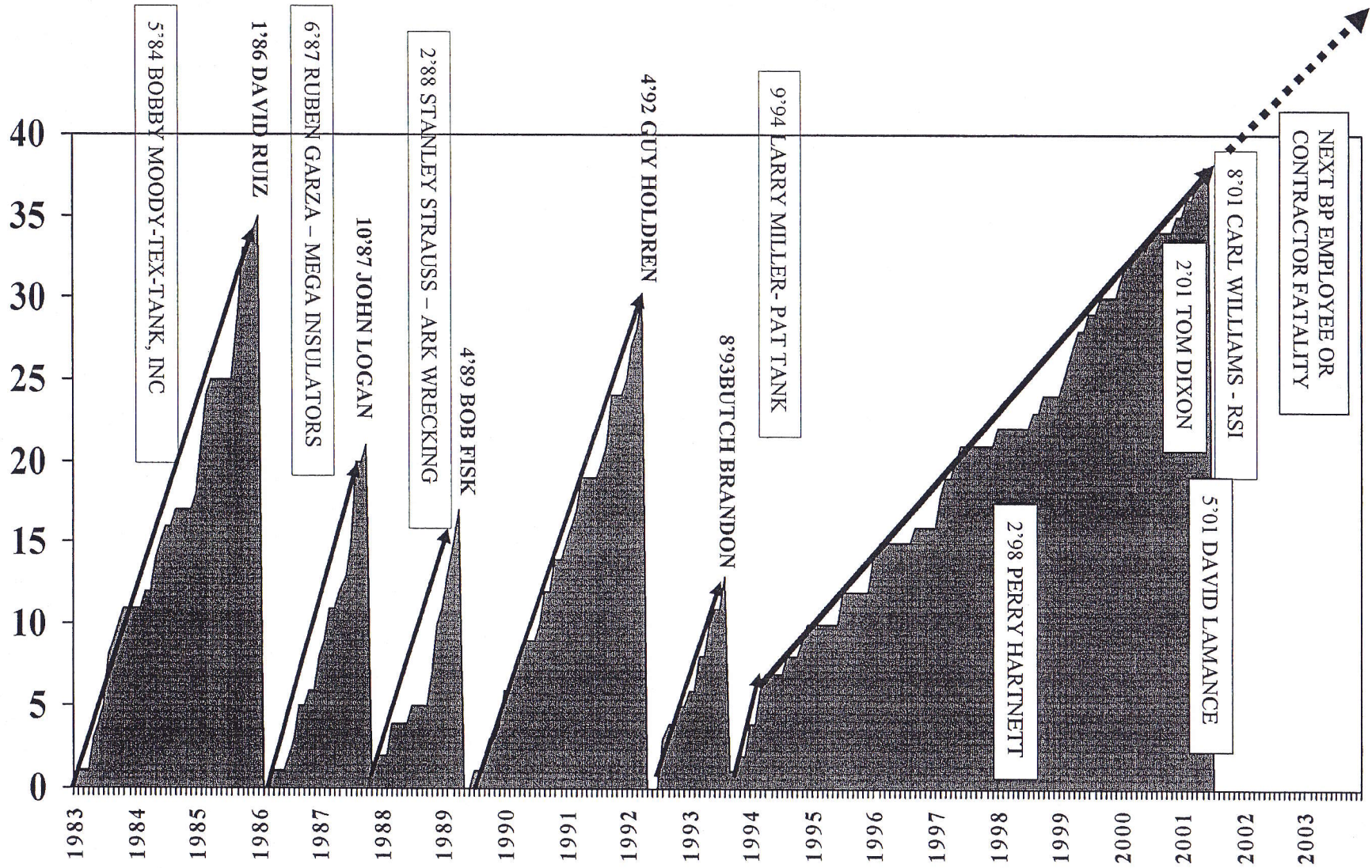


Leonard Moore, Jr. (November 16, 1964 – September 3, 2004)
