Mr. Kenny,

your quick clarification of "funding" is appreciated.

To ensure that we are all on the same page, I want to be certain that you are aware that the FOIA requires agencies to produce records in response to FOIA requests. EEOC will search for records responsive to your request and provide the properly discloseable ones to you. You should also note that there is no account or central location containing all expenditures attributable to the Texas Road House litigation and investigation. FOIA Programs has asked three headquarters offices and the District Office to search for responsive records, and advise this office of the estimated number of records, whether the records are in paper or an electronic format or both and the number of hours and personnel required to search for the records. As soon as this information is made available, we will be in communication with you.

In the interim, please do not hesitate to me or Ms. Durham with any questions relating to the two pending FOIA requests.

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
