This is in response to your August 6, 2014, Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request. A copy of your request is enclosed for your reference. We received your request on August 8, 2014, and assigned it case number FOIA-2014-00672.

The Office of the Deputy Inspector General for Administrative Investigations conducted a search and located two documents, totaling 46 pages, responsive to your request. I determined that the documents are exempt from release in their entirety pursuant to 5 U.S.C. § 552(b)(6), which pertains to information, the release of which would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy; and 5 U.S.C. § 552(b)(7)(C), which pertains to records or information compiled for law enforcement purposes, the release of which could reasonably be expected to constitute an unwarranted invasion of personal privacy.

If you are not satisfied with this action, you may submit an administrative appeal to the Department of Defense, Office of Inspector General, Office of Communications and Congressional Liaison, ATTN: FOIA Appellate Authority, Suite 17F18, 4800 Mark Center Drive, Alexandria, VA 22350-1500. Your appeal should be postmarked within 30 days of the date of this letter, should cite to case number FOIA-2014-00672, and should be clearly marked "Freedom of Information Act Appeal."
