MN Stabilizes in Final Week: Democrat Biden and DFL Senate Candidate Smith Both with Single-Digit, Not Insurmountable Leads; 59 and Sunny Forecast for Election Day, Which GOP Will Need if Trump and Lewis Want Drama When Gopher State Votes Are Counted:

A week after lifting himself into an effective tie with incumbent Senator Tina Smith, Republican challenger Jason Lewis had emergency hernia surgery and newly wakes from the anesthesia to find himself today a nominal 3 points back with 6 days to go, still within striking distance, according to SurveyUSA research conducted exclusively for KSTP-TV in the Twin Cities and other Hubbard Broadcasting properties across Minnesota.

In 4 identical SurveyUSA tracking polls, Lewis' support has increased steadily, from 36% in early September to 42% last week and today. Though Smith is treading water, absent any momentum, she has never dropped below 43% and [ends today](#) at 45%. Smith has surrendered a 17-point advantage she had among the state's [youngest voters](#), has seen a 21-point erosion in support among [high-school educated](#) voters, and has given up a 19 point edge among [middle-income voters](#).

1/3 of likely voters have already returned a ballot. Smith's salvation is that she leads by 38 points among this group. Among those who tell SurveyUSA they will vote in person on Election Day 11/03/2020, Lewis leads by 22 points, every one of which votes could be impacted by bad weather on Election Day, surging COVID, innocent mechanical malfunction, or nefarious systemic breakdowns. Chuck Schumer has little chance of capturing a majority in the US Senate without holding Smith's seat as one of the 50 he must have if Joseph R. Biden is elected President or 51 Senators he must have if Donald J. Trump is re-elected.

In the fight for Minnesota's 10 electoral votes, Trump today is close as he has ever been to Biden in 4 SurveyUSA tracking polls, but that is still 5 points aft of Biden's stern. Certainly, Biden has no momentum in Minnesota, where he started at 49% in early September and ends today at 47%. But any momentum Trump may have is microscopic. He started at 40% in early September and ends today at 42%, which he has achieved in 2 of 4 polls. Best guess:

* **Biden 47%** .

* **Trump 42%** .

* A comparatively large 5% (by 2020 standards) are voting for a minor-party candidate.

Trump trails among suburban men, which is a "must win" group given the truism that Biden will capture suburban women, which Biden does, by 14 points. Though Trump leads by nearly 2:1 in rural MN, Biden offsets and leads by 2:1 in urban MN. Trump gains ground among [high-school educated voters](#), where he finishes up by 17 points over Biden, his largest lead of the Fall. But Biden offsets with a late surge among [lower-income voters](#), where he finishes up by 23 points, his strongest showing of the Fall.

Across 4 tracking polls, the percentage of MN registered voters with an "extremely favorable" opinion of Trump has increased from 21% in early September to 27% today. The number of MN registered voters with an "extremely **un**-favorable" opinion of Trump has slowly by steadily declined, from 45% in September to 41% today. The warming to Trump is most pronounced in Southern MN, the border region that MN shares with battleground state Iowa. Biden's, Lewis' and Smith's favorability numbers are largely unchanged across the same 4 polls.

Trump by a narrow 48% to 42% margin today is seen by MN voters as stronger [on the economy](#). Biden by an even narrower 47% to 43% margin today is seen by MN voters as the candidate who would keep Minnesotans safer. Before the 2nd debate between Trump and Biden, voters told SurveyUSA they backed Biden by 4 points, 46% to 42%. After the debate, voters told SurveyUSA they backed Biden by 4 points, 47% to 43%. Today, 6 days after the debate, it's Biden by 5 points, 47% to 42%.

Of voters who have already returned a ballot, Biden leads Trump by the same 38 points that Smith leads Lewis, 64% to 26%. Though a plurality of voters, 40%, say they will vote on Election Day, Trump would need to outperform the 19-point lead SurveyUSA shows Trump having today among in-person 11/03/2020 voters. Any climatological, epidemiological, or mechanical event on Election Day may suppress turnout, which disproportionately affects the GOP up and down the ballot.

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Statement of Methodology: SurveyUSA is an independent, non-partisan, apolitical research company that conducts opinion surveys for media, academic institutions, commercial clients, non-profits, governments, agencies, and elected officials. SurveyUSA opinion research is conducted using a methodology optimized for each particular project. In some cases, this means data is collected 100% by telephone; in some cases, 100% online; and in other cases, a blend of the two. For those projects that are conducted "mixed-mode" (or "multi-mode"): Respondents who have a home (landline) telephone are interviewed by phone, sometimes using live interviewers, other times using the recorded voice of a professional announcer. The youngest male is requested on approximately 30% of calls to home phones, the youngest adult is requested on approximately 70% of calls. This method of intra-household selection reduces the potential for age and gender imbalance in the unweighted sample. Re-attempts are made to busy signals, no-answers, and answering machines. Landline telephone sample is purchased from Aristotle of Washington DC. Respondents who do not use a home telephone are interviewed on an electronic device, which means, for some projects, that call-center employees hand-dial cell phones and interview respondents verbally on the respondent's cell phone, and means, for other projects, that SurveyUSA displays the questions visually on the respondent's phone, tablet, or other device. Sample for respondents who do not use a home telephone is purchased from Aristotle or from one of several other research companies that provide access to cell respondents. Where meaningful, SurveyUSA indicates the percentage of respondents who use a home phone and the percentage who do not, and crosstabs by this distinction. Responses are minimally weighted to U.S. Census or voter file targets for gender, age and race. Target (cell) weighting is used. On questionnaires that ask about political party identification, SurveyUSA may or may not weight to Party ID, depending on client preference. Where necessary, questions and answer choices are rotated to prevent order bias, recency, and latency effects. On some studies, certain populations are over-sampled, so that the number of unweighted respondents exceeds the number of weighted respondents. Each individual SurveyUSA release contains the date(s) on which interviews are conducted and a release date. If interviewing for a particular study is conducted in Spanish, or in any other foreign language, it will be noted on the specific release. If no notation appears, interviews are conducted in English. Where respondents are filtered, such as adults, filtered to registered voters, in turn filtered to likely voters, SurveyUSA describes the filtering on the specific release. On pre-election polls in geographies with early voting, SurveyUSA differentiates between respondents who have already voted and those who are likely to vote but have not yet done so. On research completed prior to 12/31/16, SurveyUSA assigned to each question within the instrument a theoretical margin of sampling error. Effective 01/01/17, SurveyUSA assigns to each question within the instrument a credibility interval, which better reflects the sampling uncertainties associated with gathering some percentage of respondent answers using non-probability sample. Though commonly cited in the presentation of research results, "sampling error" is only one of many types of error that may influence the outcome of an opinion research study. More practical concerns include the way in which questions are worded and ordered, the inability to contact some, the refusal of others to be interviewed, and the difficulty of translating each questionnaire into all possible languages and dialects. Non-sampling errors cannot be quantified. This statement conforms to the principles of disclosure as recommended by the National Council on Public Polls (NCPP).
