BLM is currently in the initial process review of potentially responsive material to your request.

We use Multitrack Processing to process FOIA requests. The Simple track is for requests that would generally take one to five workdays to process. The Normal track is for requests that would generally take six to twenty workdays to process. The Complex track is for requests that would generally take twenty-one to sixty workdays to process. The Extraordinary track is for requests that would generally take more than sixty workdays to process. The Expedited track is for requests that have been granted expedited processing, which are processed as soon as practicable. Within each track, requests are usually processed on a first-in, first-out basis. Your request falls into the "Complex" processing track.

BLM has determined there to be approximately 63 pages of potentially responsive material to your request. BLM expects that material will require review under FOIA exemption 4 for confidential/sensitive/trade secret/proprietary information. As such, this material will require consultation with the Submitter(s) of said information to BLM.

Once the time period for response is reached and/or a response is received from the Submitter(s), BLM will review records and responses in full, in accordance with the FOIA's 9 exemptions and provide to your a response on or before August 3, 2020.

For your information, Congress excluded three discrete categories of law enforcement and national security records from the requirements of FOIA. 5 U.S.C. 552(c). This response is limited to those records that are subject to the requirements of FOIA. This is a standard notification that is given to all our requesters and should not be taken as an indication that excluded records do, or do not, exist.

The 2007 FOIA amendments created the Office of Government Information Services (OGIS) to offer mediation services to resolve disputes between FOIA requesters and Federal agencies as a non-exclusive alternative to litigation.
