This is a response to your December 14, 2020 open records request. You requested the following records from October 1, 2020 until the day the request is processed:

- Any and all correspondence between this agency and the U.S. Centers for Disease Control and Prevention about vaccine priority, including emails, presentations, recordings, photographs, and memos, about vaccine distribution and prioritization plans;
- Any and all correspondence between this agency and stakeholders (including private companies and their representatives and their attorneys, nonprofit groups, advisory committees, elected officials, and county-and-local health officials) including emails, presentations, recordings, photographs, and memos about vaccine distribution and prioritization plans;
- Any documents about or referring to algorithms, computer programs, partnerships, or software that will be used to help determine vaccine priority and distribution;
- Any presentations, pdfs, or legal analyses about vaccine priority and distribution; and
- Any communication with law enforcement (state, local, or national) about vaccine priority and distribution plan

Your request is overly broad and cannot be fulfilled as requested. *State el rel. Gehl v. Connors, 2007 WI App 238, ¶ 23, 742 N.W.2d 530 (Ct. App. 2007)*. Attempts were made on January 5, 2021 and January 12, 2021 to reach you to clarify and narrow the request, however to date you have not responded. We are therefore denying your request.

If you believe that the Department of Health Services has improperly determined that the materials related to your request, please do not hesitate to contact me. Further, if you do so believe, you have a right under Wis. Stat. § 19.37 to have the determination reviewed by *mandamus* or upon application to the attorney general or district attorney.
