The Department of Homeland Security (DHS) has received your appeal of the response by **DHS Privacy** to your Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request regarding:

- 1) documents sufficient to show the scope, purpose and objectives of "Operation Palladium";
- 2) documents sufficient to show the number of offices assigned to Operation Palladium;
- 3) communications between ICE, DHS, and other law enforcement agencies for the implementation of Operation Palladium.

On behalf of the Deputy Associate General Counsel for General Law, we acknowledge your appeal and are assigning it number **2020-HQAP-00179** for tracking purposes. Please reference this number in any future communications about your appeal.

A high number of FOIA requests have been received by the Department.
