Hi there - Yes surviving here but sometimes barely ;). The only way the Social Worker has been able to provide direct SW minutes is to provide twice weekly whole class sessions (by pods) through Google Classroom. I just made sure that she is documenting these minutes in the service logs for individual students who require direct minutes.

The only technology means is one laptop in each pod (think "cell" really) and then a large screen tv monitor. The guard hooks up the laptop to the TV, pushes the button and the students in the pod observe and listen to the teacher or SW on the large screen tv monitor and interact through the camera and microphone on the laptop. The students are not allowed to touch the laptop. When class is complete, the guard disconnects and removes equipment. All instruction is done this way. Even school in non-pandemic times, the students do not access the internet or chromebooks.

For Nursing minutes with indirect or consult and OT/PT - let me find out how they are working with the Detention Center staff. Currently there are no students with direct OT/PT or Nursing but I'm not sure how that would work if need be. I know the Nurse can check with Detention Center staff on meds but I'll find out the formal process. There are so many constraints in this environment. I know it is jail and there are limits on personal rights but with Deputy Chief Parker, I wasn't being flippant when I said I hope ISBE can take on the juvenile justice system.
