**AGREED ORDER GRANTING SUBPOENA DUCES TECUM**

THIS DAY this cause came before the Court on the request of John Davis, by and through his counsel, requesting the Court to grant an Agreed Order for Subpoena Duces Tecum for additional discovery in this matter which in likelihood contains exculpatory information, and the Court after being advised that counsel for Mr. Davis has communicated with the Mississippi Department of Human Services, and the documents can be produced but a Subpoena Duces Tecum is necessary, and the Hinds County Assistant District Attorney agrees to the SDT, the Court finds the request is well taken and the same is hereby granted.

**Request for Production 1.** Produce the Mississippi Community Education Center Yearly Final Fiscal Report filed at the end of each year with the Mississippi Department of Human Services for the years 2017-2020.

**Request for Production 2.** Produce any Response that the Mississippi Department of Human Services made back to the Mississippi Community Education Center in response to the Final Fiscal Report referred to in question 1, for the years 2017-2020.

**Request for Production 3.** Produce reports, summaries, or notes of any kind regarding the Regional TANF office's yearly telephonic reviews or the yearly in-person visits to the Mississippi Department of Human Services for 2017-2020.

**Request for Production 4.** Produce reports, summaries, or notes of any kind regarding the Regional TANF office's yearly telephonic reviews or the yearly in-person visits to the Mississippi Community Education Center 2017-2020.

**Request for Production 5.** Produce reports, summaries, or notes of any kind regarding the 2018 visit by LaMonica Shelton, Regional Program Manager Administration for Children and Families, Office of Family Assistance to the Mississippi Community Education Center.

**Request for Production 6:** Produce the Bank's name and account number where the Mississippi Department of Human Services deposited any funds from MDHS into Mississippi Community Educational Center's bank.

**Request for Production 7:** Produce the single audit for the years 2017-2020 produced by Mississippi Community Educational Center required by the Single Audit Act of 1996.

**Request for Production 8:** Produce any supplemental audit or review of subgrantee Mississippi Community Educational Center (MCEC) as it relates to the use of money for drug and alcohol treatment for Brett DiBiase.

**Request for Production 9:** Produce the written Monthly Reports to Mississippi Department of Human Services for December 2018 through July 2019 by Mississippi Community Educational Center (MCEC) as required under SECTION XIX, MONTHLY REPORTING of the MCEC contract.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that the Mississippi Department of Human Services shall provide the following information to the Hinds County District Attorney's Office and to counsel for Mr. Davis:


