Dear Mr. Cole:

As you know, we have been reviewing the materials that you provided to the Pennsylvania Innocence Project for review. I apologize that our review has taken such a long time, but you sent a great deal of information which my students had to review carefully. However, I am very sorry to tell you that the Pennsylvania Innocence Project will be unable to pursue your case further. The Project is a very small organization with extremely limited resources, and we have to set strict guidelines for ourselves to function as effectively as possible. When we review a case, the primary concern for us is that the inmate was convicted of a crime he did not do and that he had no involvement in whatsoever.

In your case, there were many troubling aspects to your trial and appeals. I am particularly concerned about some of the constitutional and procedural matters that seem to have taken place. However, given where you are in the process, as you know the only method of proving innocence at this stage is by developing new evidence which could lead to your exoneration, and which would overcome the evidence presented against you at trial. There do not seem to be any viable avenues for that in your case. The hardest part of this Project is having to say no to people whose cases we find meritorious, but for whom we can do nothing. I am truly sorry to say that yours is such a case. Because there does not appear to be any avenue for finding new evidence to establish your innocence, the Pennsylvania Innocence Project cannot pursue your case further.
