

NARRATIVE

On 12/25/19 at approximately 0906, I, Trooper Smith responded to assist Kiowa County Sheriff's Office in an active pursuit on H385 near Sheridan Lake. Upon my arrival the suspect vehicle could not be located. The vehicle was located later on Prowers County Road 39 and KK. A pursuit began with Kiowa SO and again the vehicle was lost and later located in a dry creek bed. The driver fled on foot and was not located. Agencies involved were Kansas Highway Patrol, Kiowa SO, Prowers SO and myself. The search was terminated at 1539 hours.

NARRATIVE:

On 12/25/2019 I overheard that Kiowa County was in pursuit of a Black Chevrolet pickup. The location was in the Sheridan Lake, Colorado area. I was working on Highway 109 south of La Junta and was not going to respond. A short time later I heard that the Kiowa deputy lost sight of the pickup. I started to work my way towards Highway 96 in case the vehicle decided to come west.

At approximately 1128 hours, Kiowa County Deputies got a call that the pickup was parked on the shoulder of Kiowa County Road 78. Since I was on Highway 96 I started to head that way. I responded to approximately Prowers County Road KK and County Road 39. I was met by the Hamilton County Sheriff who asked for my assistance in searching a barn. After the barn was cleared Baca County Deputy George searched the basement of the residence, at the request of the home owner.

After I cleared the area of the home, I met up with Trooper Smith and several Troopers from Kansas. I learned that the suspect had run the truck into the creek and fled. I also learned that the southern end of

the creek that the truck came to rest in was not secured. I responded to that area and watched until the search was called off.

Once the search was suspended, I went back to the residence at CR KK and CR 39. I advised the residence that the suspect had not been caught and to be careful because he had to be still in the area.

I left the residence and headed towards Lamar. At approximately CR JJ and CR 38 I observed a Kiowa County Sheriff's Department pickup crashed into the ditch. I exited and check to make sure it was secured. I found that the doors were unlocked and there were weapons inside it. At approximately 1618 hours, I called Sheriff Casey Sheridan and asked if he wanted to do something with this unsecured vehicle. He ask that I just lock it and put the keys in the fuel cap.

As I was about to clear, Prowers County Deputy Madrid and Kiowa County Deputy Snover arrived. I was advised they had called a tow truck and Prowers was doing a crash report. I cleared the scene.

Ref the Pursuit veh - 2019 Chevy Truck - California plates

Veh was located in Prowers County -- Prowers county road KK and Prowers county road 39 (which is the Colorado/Kansas state line north of Holly)
Vehicle was involved in a short pursuit - where it tried to run over a Kiowa County Deputy -- vehicle then took off cross country again through a field and left in a creek bed -- suspect left the vehicle and continued on foot through the creekbed - south from the vehicle

After an extensive search with K9 units, two Airborne units, the suspect was not located -- suspect is still at large at this time
