While processing your request, the U.S. Citizenship and Immigration Services (USCIS) located records that fall under the purview of the Department of Homeland Security (DHS), Immigration and Customs Enforcement. 
Due to the increasing number of FOIA requests received by this office, we may encounter some delay in processing your request. Per §5.5(a) of the DHS FOIA regulations, 6 C.F.R. Part 5, the Department processes FOIA requests according to their order of receipt. Although DHS' goal is to respond within 20 business days of receipt of your request, the FOIA does permit a 10-day extension of this time period. As the subject matter of your request is of substantial interest to two or more components of this Department or of substantial interest to another agency, we will need to consult with those entities before we issue a final response. Due to these unusual circumstances, DHS will invoke a 10-day extension for your request, as allowed by Title 5 U.S. C. § 552(a)(6)(B). We will make every effort to comply with your request in a timely manner; however, there are currently 2378 open requests ahead of yours.

We will construe the submission of your request as an agreement to pay up to \$25.00. You will be contacted before any further fees are accrued.
