Ms. Matthew (and Mr. Coburn),

Thank you for your e-mail. I tried to give you a call to discuss the below this morning, but am following up now by e-mail and am available to discuss today by phone at your convenience.

I believe that we have a misunderstanding as to when Willkie Farr & Gallagher LLP ("Willkie") was actually provided the letter to which you refer, which—per the attached two e-mails from you **on December 2, 2020**—were not actually "closed" or provided to Willkie until you yourself delivered them on December 2, 2020 (as opposed to the incorrect date on the notice, which appears to have been backdated to November 25, 2020). Furthermore, on that same day,

November 25, 2020, you yourself indicated by e-mail that the appeal was still "with the final releasing authority or Initial Denial Authority for review and signature," and further added that on that same date, you were "hoping to have your FOIA finalized over the next few weeks." The Agency is simply mistaken that Willkie's administrative appellate rights began to run as of that date, when you yourself conceded that the production had neither been approved, nor released, nor even signed, and that you yourself did not expect such finalization to take place for weeks. Instead, you provided that final release only on December 2, 2020, the date that Willkie's appellate rights actually began to run, regardless of the incorrect date on the internal transmission letter.

Thus, it is Willkie's position that, while the incorrect date on the attachment may have indicated 25 November 2020, the communication actually conveying and attaching the production and the "adverse response" to our FOIA request (i.e., your e-mail) was not dated until December 2, 2020, when they were transmitted to Willkie. This comports with JBSA FOIA regulations, which indicate that Willkie may appeal in writing within 90 calendar days from the date conveying the Agency's response as an adverse action, which did not occur until December 2, 2020. It is thus Willkie's position that that Willkie cannot fairly (or legally) be imputed with the Agency's 8-day delay in your system from November 25 to December 2, 2020, which instead is the date that controls Willkie's administrative appellate rights. Furthermore, 90 days from that date is March 2, 2021, the date you concede Willkie submitted its appeal.

Given the above, Willkie asks that you please revisit your incorrect determination that our appeal has been closed, and provide a full appellate determination within 20 working days of today (March 29, 2021). As you know, a FOIA appeal-seeker's rights require that an administrative appellate decision be reached within 20 working days of submission, which would mean that our appeal would be due within 20 working days of March 2, 2021 (i.e., the Agency's response would be due tomorrow, March 30, 2021). However, given that you have been out of the office and only returned recently, and given your misunderstanding of when Plaintiff was actually in receipt of the letter providing the adverse response, Willkie is willing to grant the Agency the additional 20 days from today to provide a formal appellate decision upon your confirmation that a full appeal will be granted to our FOIA request. If, however, the Agency is unwilling to reconsider its mistaken and premature closing of Willkie's FOIA appeal, Willkie will be forced to begin litigation to vitiate our rights. We believe such litigation is entirely unnecessary and costly—especially considering that our appeal is limited to just a single FOIA—but without reconsideration of the Agency's mistaken closing of our case, we will be left with no alternative. Please advise no later than tomorrow, March 30, 2020, whether JBSA will be conducting a full appeal of FOIA 2020-02975-F.
