

ORDINANCE NO. 6789 C.M.S.

> AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTIONS 205 AND 206 OF THE OAKLAND TRAFFIC CODE LIMITING MOTOR TRUCK TRAFFIC ON THE MacARTHUR FREEWAY AND DESIGNATING ALTERNATE ROUTES.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oakland follows:

SECTION 1. Sections 205 and 206 of the Oakland Traffic Code are hereby amended to read as follows:

SEC. 205. LOCAL TRUCK ROUTES. The following local truck routes are hereby established for the movement of motor trucks and trucking combinations as defined in Section 200 of this code:

When authorized signs are in place giving notice thereof, the operator of any motor truck or trucking combination as defined in Section 200 of this code, shall drive on such route or routes and none other except when necessary to traverse another street or streets to a destination for the purpose of loading or unloading, but only then by such deviation from the nearest truck route as is reasonably necessary.

SEC. 206. VEHICLES EXCEEDING FOUR AND ONE-HALF TONS PROHIBITED USE OF MacARTHUR FREEWAY: (1) When authorized signs are in place giving notice thereof, the use of MacArthur Freeway (U. S. Highway 50) in any direction and for any purpose between the Oakland-San Leandro cities boundary and the Grand Avenue Interchange of the MacArthur Freeway by any motor vehicle (other than passenger busses and passenger stages referred to in Sections 1031-1036, inclusive, of the Public Utilities Code of California) when the total weight of the vehicle and load exceeds four and one-half tons is prohibited, except as allowed by Section 205 above.
(2) Motwithstanding any other provision of the Oakland Traffic Code, Nimitz Freeway (State Sign Route 17) is hereby designated an alternate route for the use of such motor vehicles as are prohibited the use of MacArthur Freeway, which alternate route shall remain unrestricted by any local regulation as to in ight limit or type of vehicle so long as this ordinance remains in effect.
(3) Sections 200, 201, 202, 203, 204 and 205, of the Oakland Traffic Code specifically by this reference are made applicable to such motor vehicles as are prohibited the use of MacArthur Freeway, and THROUGH TRUCK ROUTES " $A$ ", " $B$ ", ' $C$ " ${ }^{\prime \prime}$, and " $\mathrm{D}^{\prime \prime}$ provided by said sections are hereby designated as alternate routes for the use of such motor vehicles as are prohibited the use of MacArthur Freeway, which alternate routes shall remain unrestricted by any local regulations as to weight limit or type of vehicle so long as this ordinance remains in effect.
(4) Notwithstanding any other provision of the Oakland Traffic Code, the following local truck routes are hereby designated as alternate routes for the use of such motor vehicles as are prohibited the use of MacArthur Freeway, which alternate routes shall remain unrestricted by local regulations as to weight limit or type of vehicle so long as this ordinance remains in effect:

(5) This section, Section 206, and any ban of truck traffic on the MacArthur Freeway, whether expressed or implied in Sections 200 through 206 of the Oakland Traffic Code, shall remain in effect until January 1, 1968, and if approval of the California Department of Public Works and of the Federal Government has been obtained prior to that date to its continuation, shall remain in effect indefinitely thereafter until such time as repealed by this Council.

Said Sections 205 and 206 of the Oakland Traffic Code now read as follows: "SEC. 20E. LOCAL TRUCK ROUTES. The EOIlowing local truck routes are hereby established for the movement of motor trucks and truckins combinations as defined in Section 200 of this code:

(1) When appropriate signs are in place giving notice thereof, the use of MacArthuc Freeway (U.S. Highizay Ei) in a vesterly Hirection betiveen the Oaklanct-San Leandro cities' boundary to the distribution structure of the San Francisca-0akland Bay B-idge by any motor vehicle (other than passengec buses and passenzer stages referred to in Sections 1031-1036 inclusive of the Public Utilities Code of California) ohen the total weight of tie vehicle and load exceeds four and oneialf tons is proaibite itexcept for the purpose of loading or unloading thereon. (2) When appropriate signs are in place jiving notice there of, the use of MacA-thuc Freeway (U.S. High vay 50) in an easterly direction betiveen Broadsay and the Oakland-San Leandro cities ' boundary by any motor vehiche (other than passenger buses and passenzer stajes referred to in Sections 1J31-1036 inclusive of the Public Utilities Code of California) when the total weight of the vehicle and load exceeda four and one half ton's is prohibited except for the purpose of loading or unloading thereon. (3) Ninitz Freentay (State Sign Route 17) is hereby designated an alternate route for the use of such motor vehicles as are prohibited the use of MacArthur Freeway, which alternate route shall remain unres. tricted by any local regulation as to ojeight limit or type of vehicle so long as this ordinance cemains in effect."
