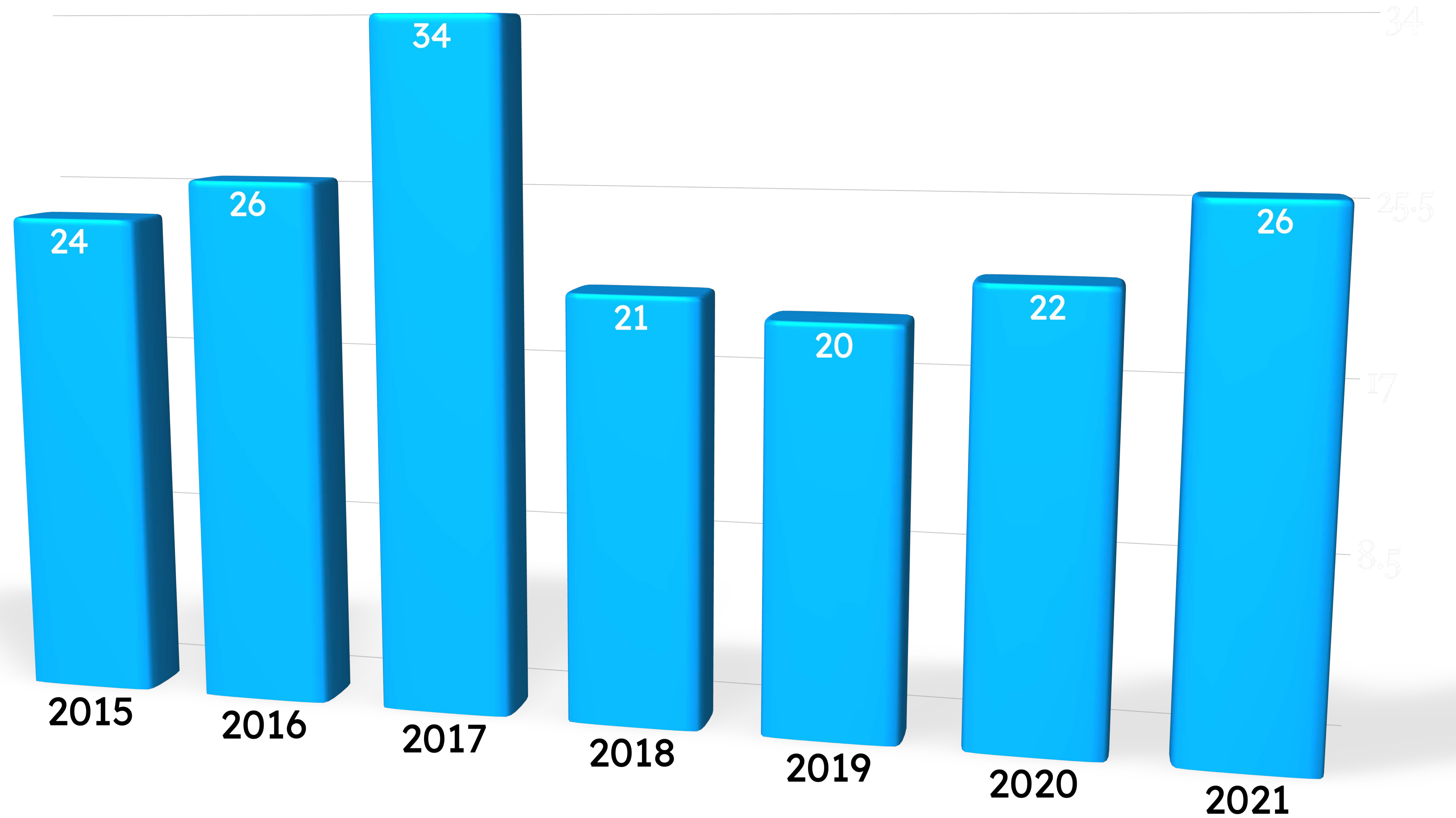

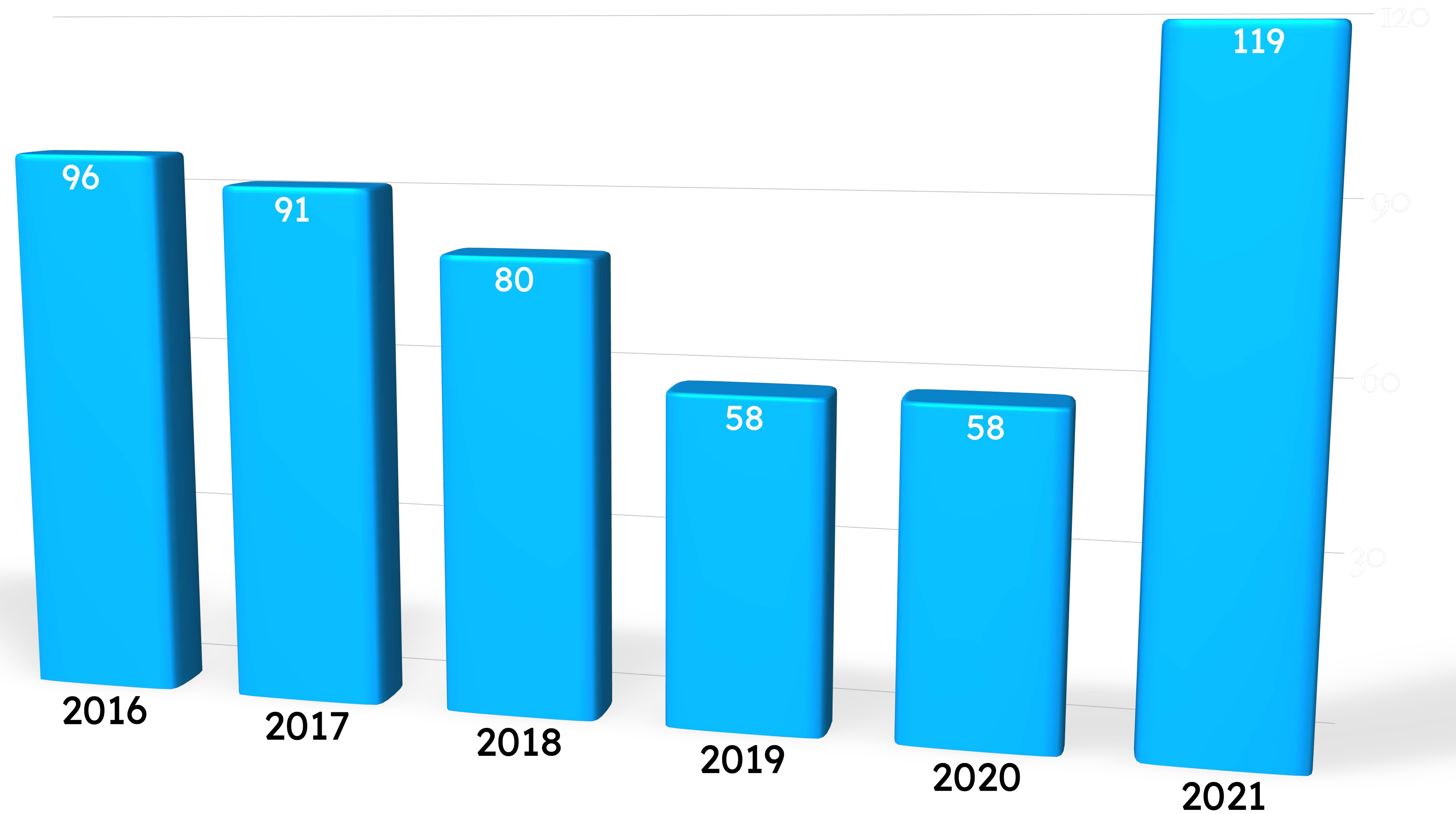
# Homicides at Mid-Year

An uptick — although 2019 was a 58-year low-point.



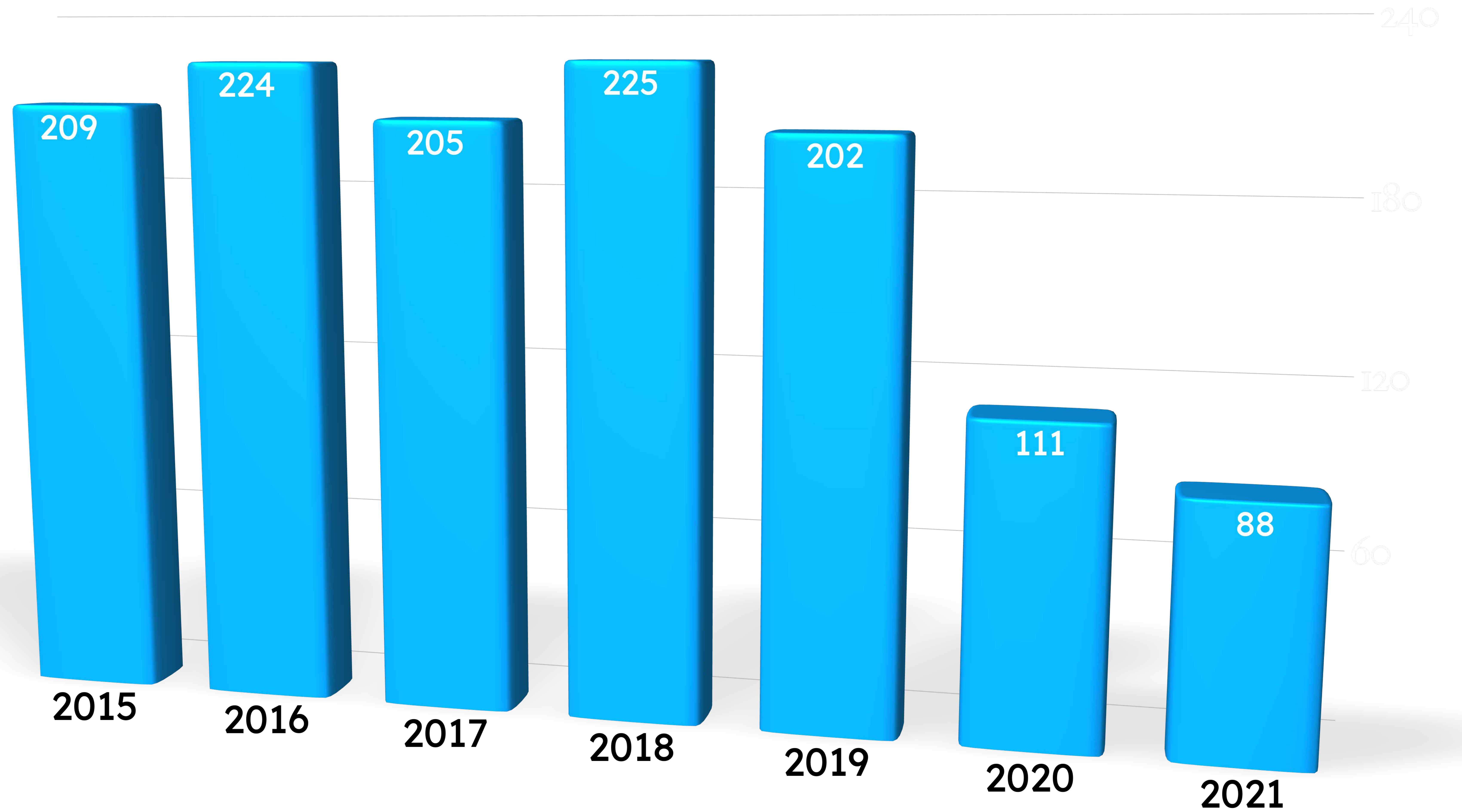
# Gun Violence Victims at Mid-Year

Reflecting victims in both fatal and non-fatal shootings.



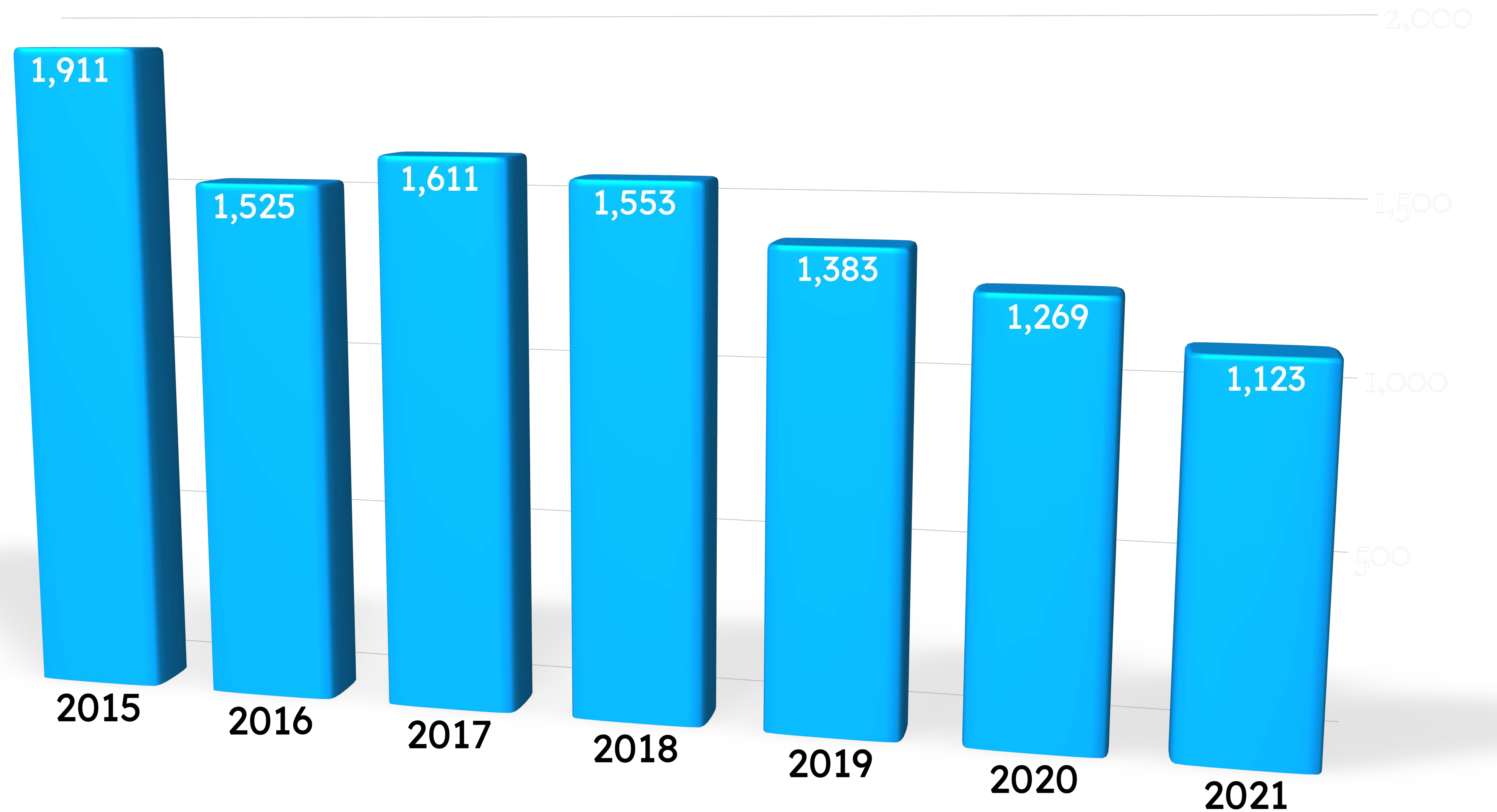
# Rape Cases at Mid-Year

Declining, but post-lockdown effect could change that.



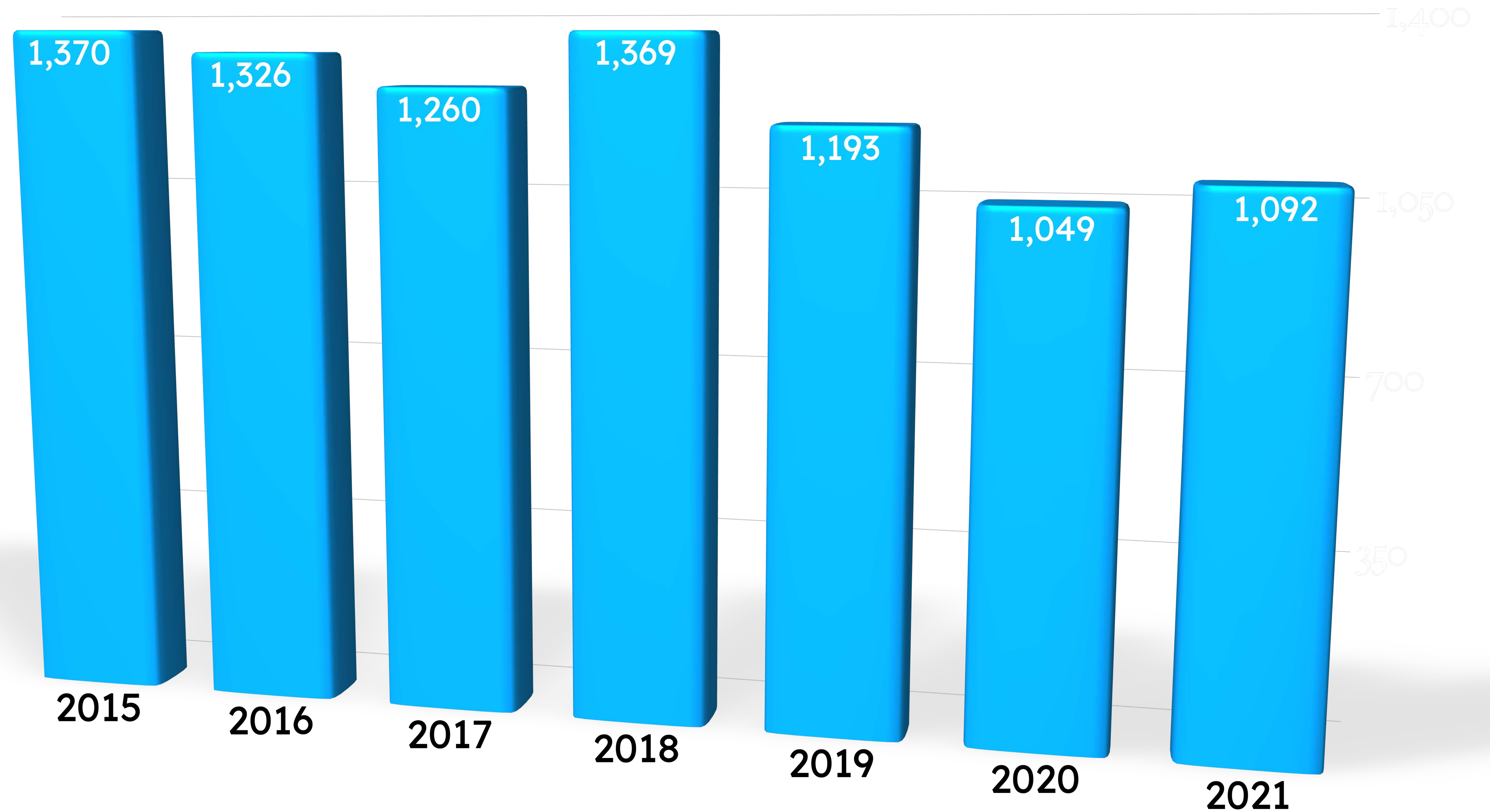
# Robberies at Mid-Year

A slight uptick over last year — and a modest long-term decline.

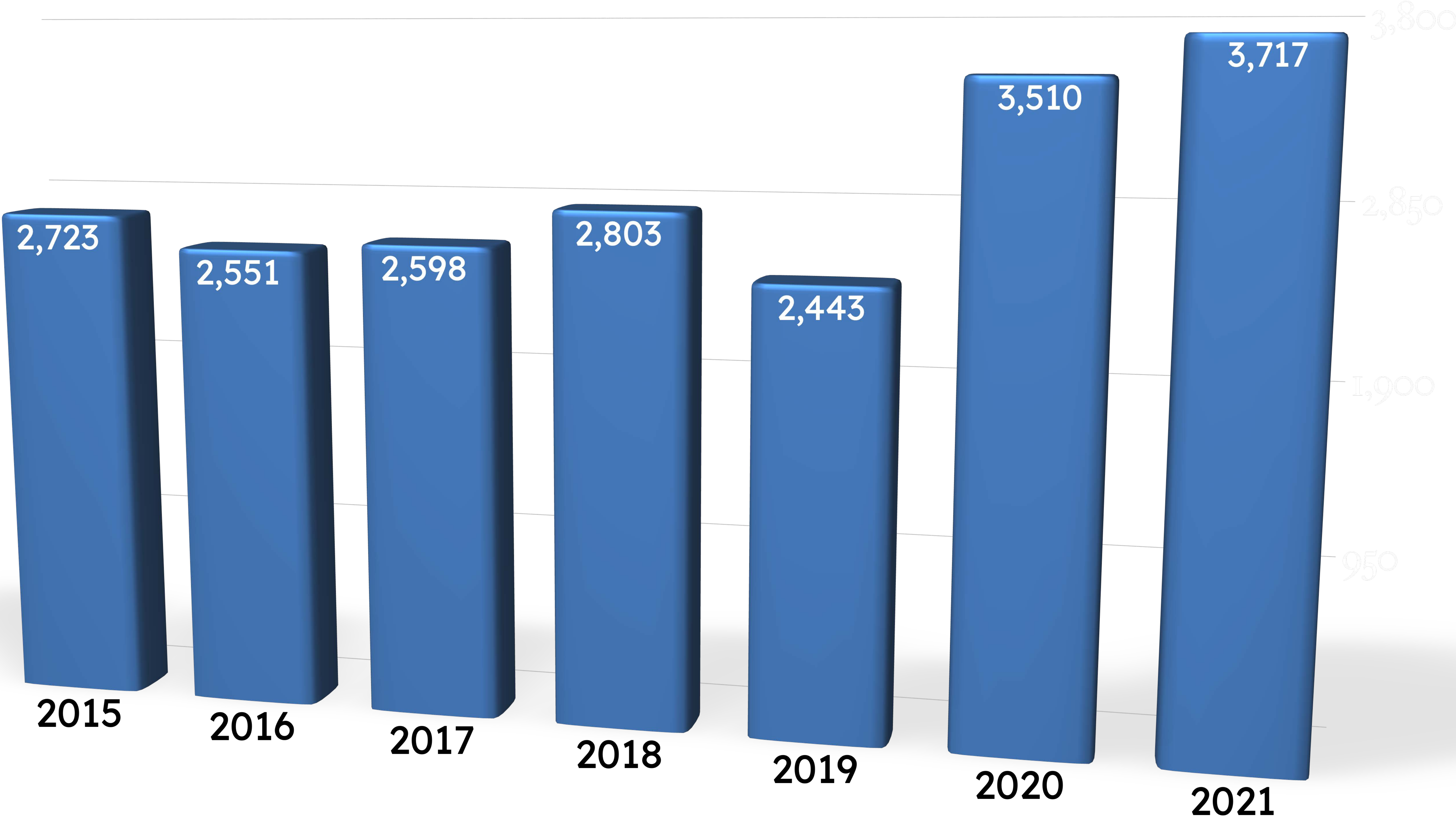

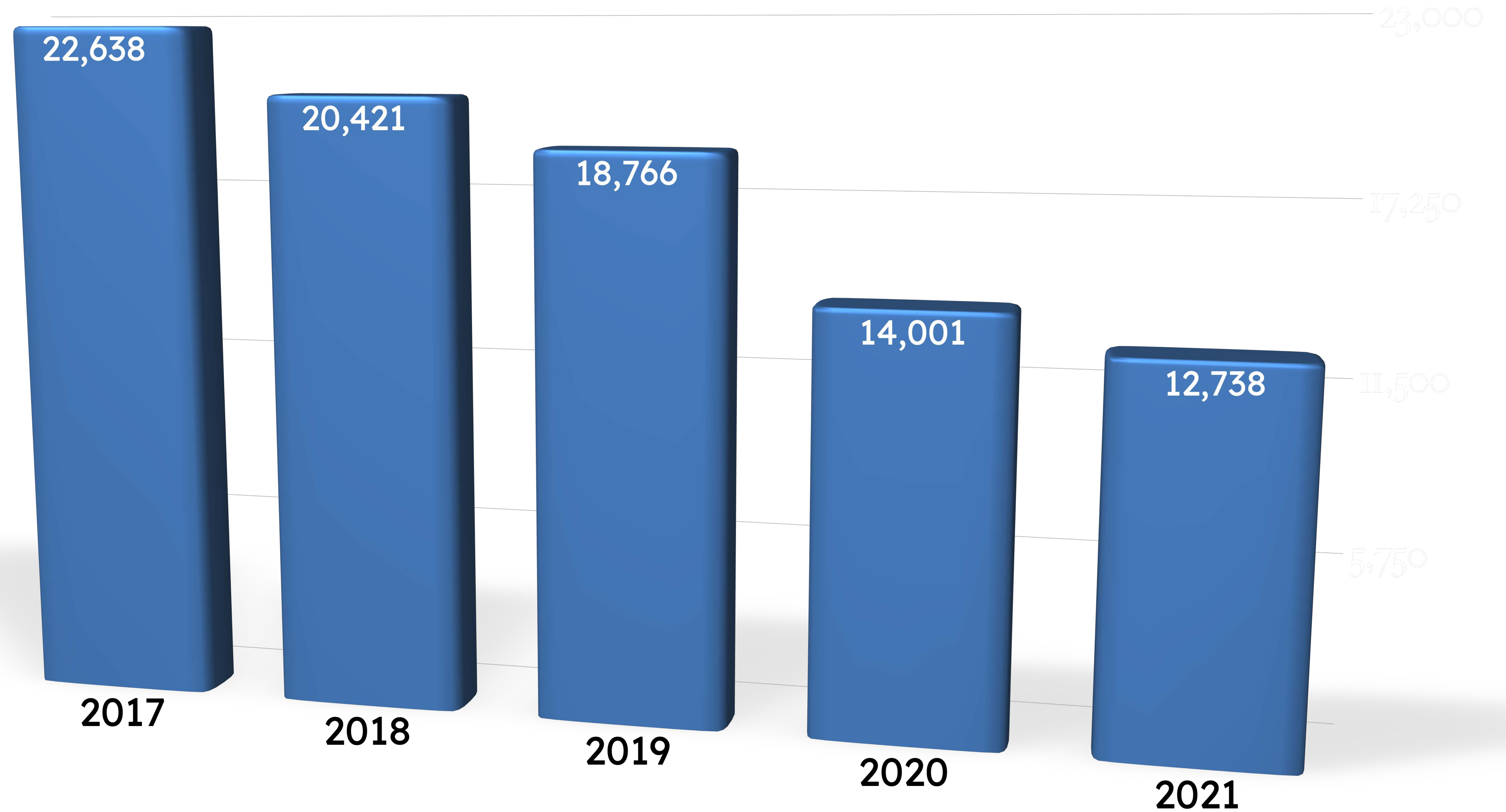
# Burglaries at Mid-Year

# Larceny/Theft at Mid-Year

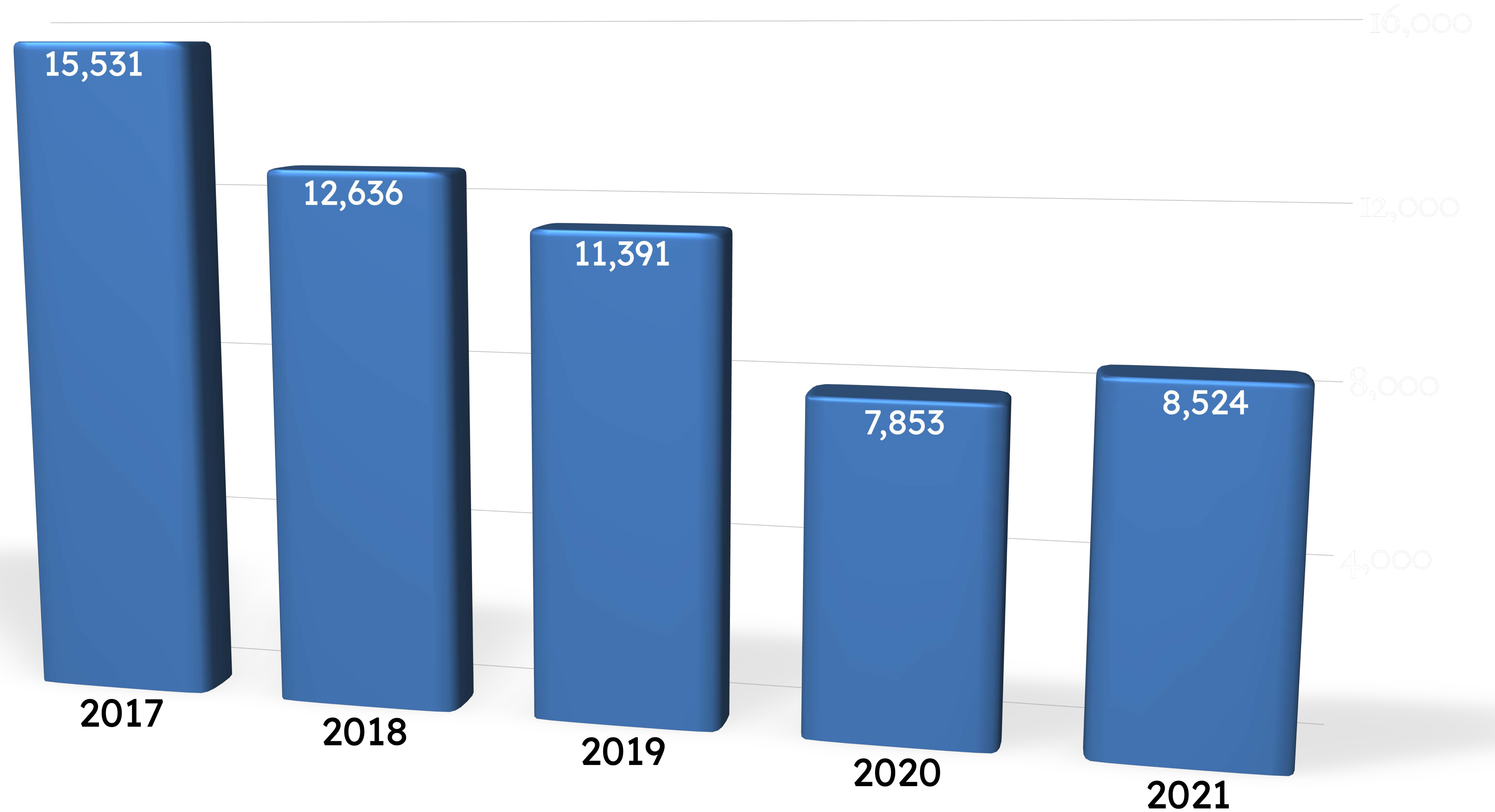
Steady decline

Larceny/Theft category includes thefts from vehicles.

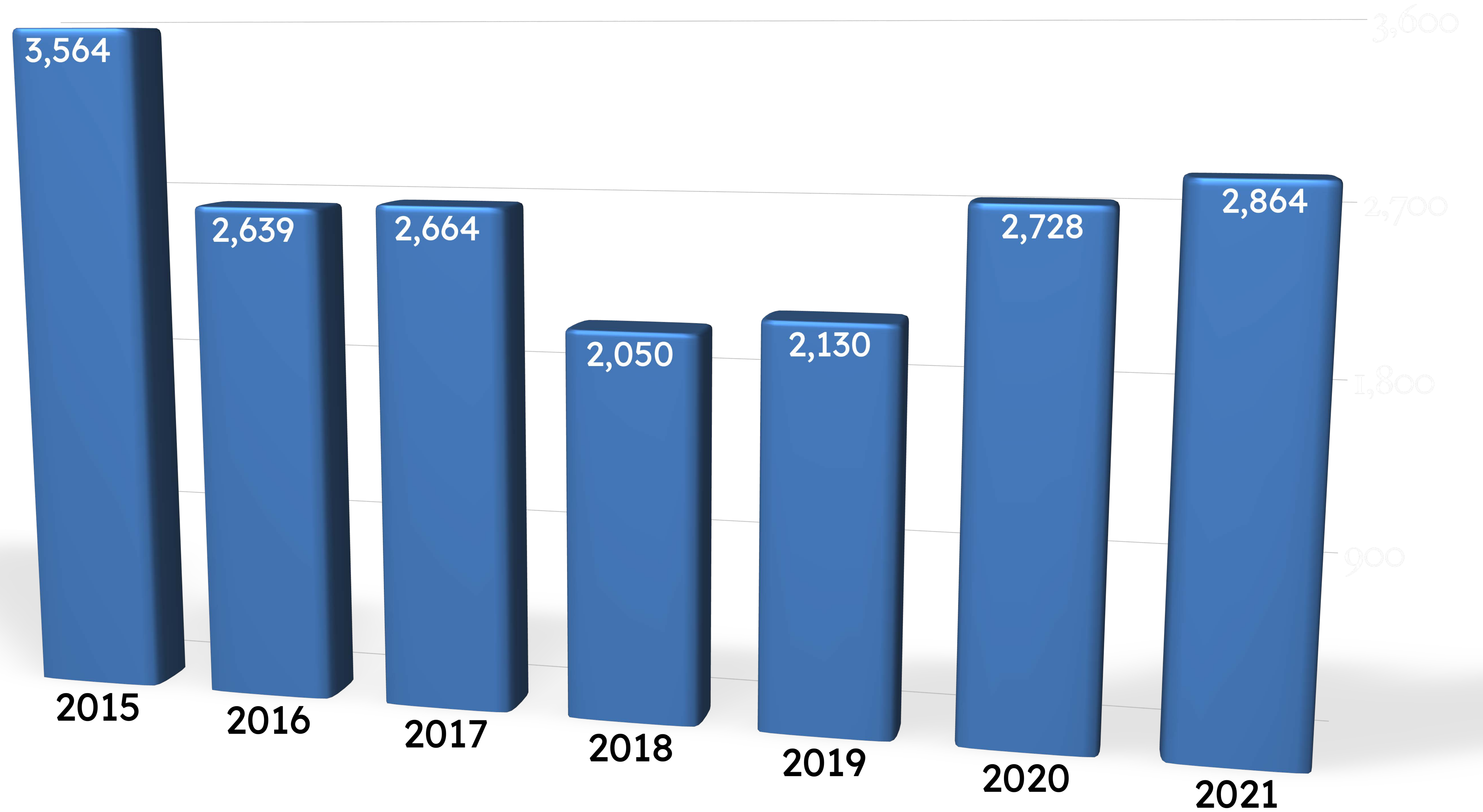
# Car Break-Ins at Mid-Year

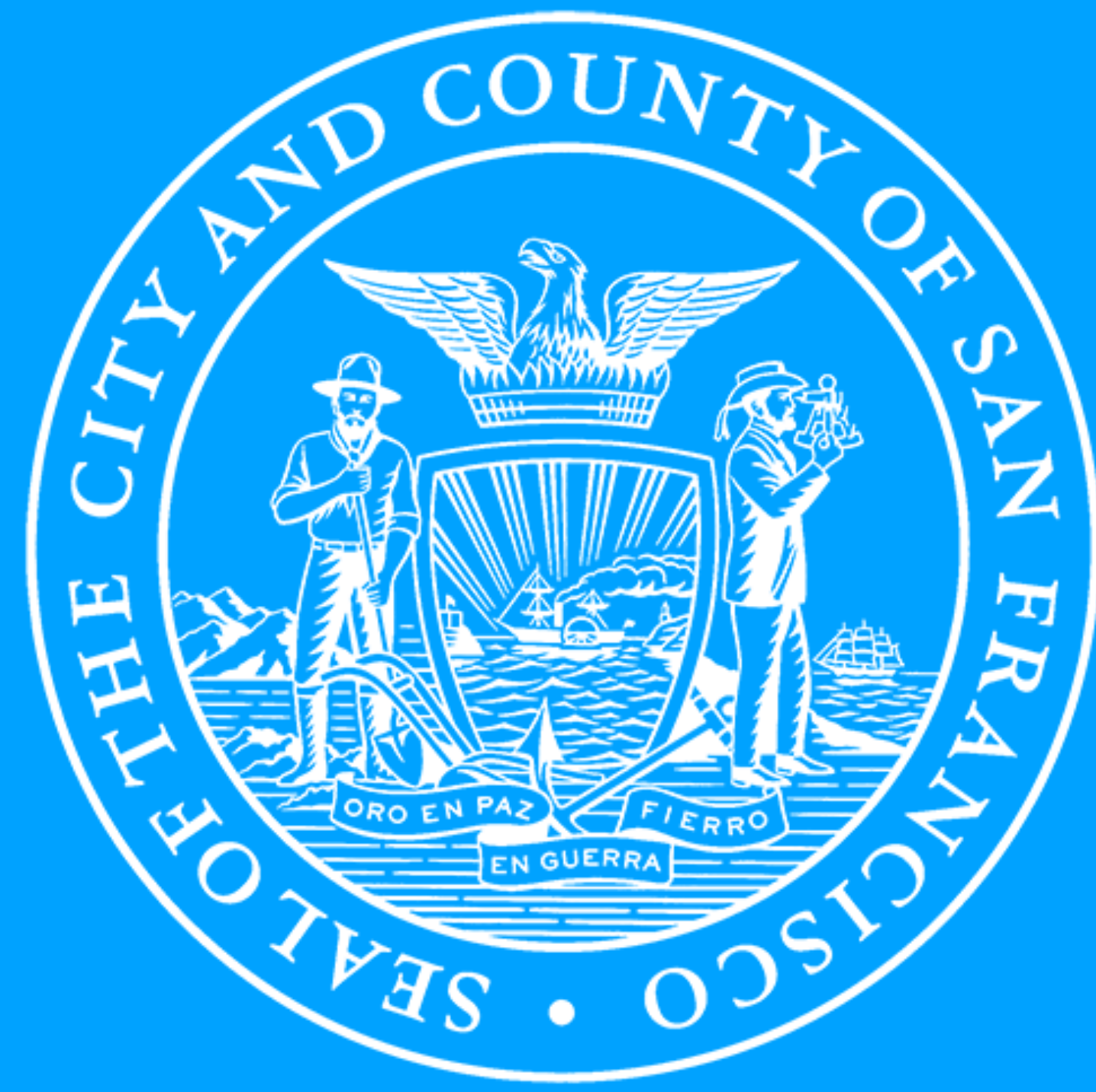
Modest uptick from 2020, but still in decline from 2017.



# Auto Thefts at Mid-Year

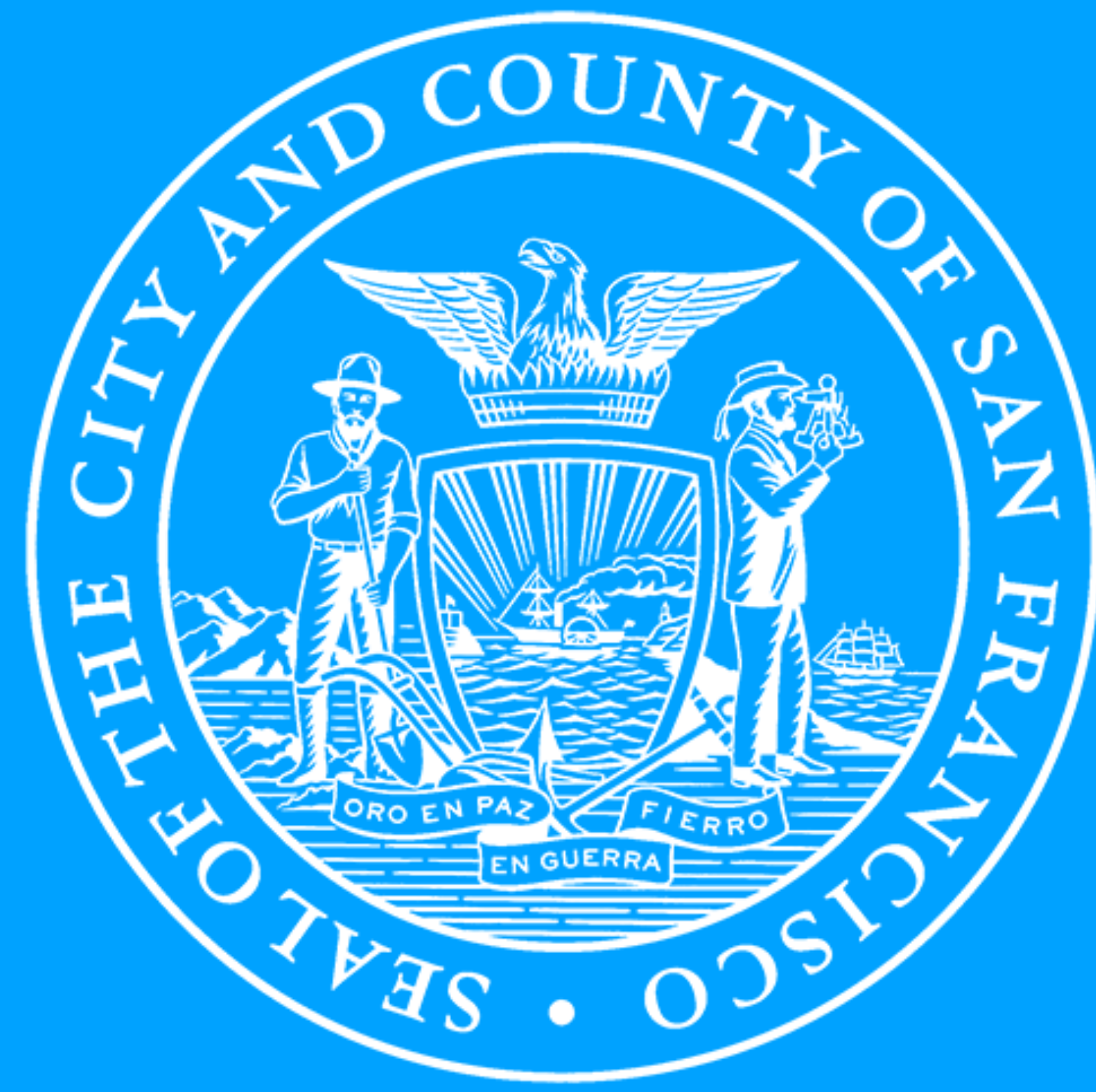
Not the trend
