

## Part 1 Violent Crimes


### Homicides at Mid-Year

An uptick—although 2019 was a 58-year low-point.




#### Gun Violence Victims at Mid-Year

Reflecting victims in both fatal and non-fatal shootings.




## Rape Cases at Mid-Year

Declining, but post-lockdown effect could change that.




### Robberies at Mid-Year

Declining, with no changes observed yet as San Francisco reopens.



## Aggravated Assaults at Mid-Year


A slight uptick over last year — and a modest long-term decline.



# Part 1 Property Crimes


## Burglaries at Mid-Year

A troubling increase — although initial post-lockdown numbers show a small decline.



## Larceny/Theft at Mid-Year


Steady decline in Larceny/
Theft crimes since formula change in 2017.



Larceny/Theft category includes thefts from vehicles.


### Car Break-Ins at Mid-Year


Modest uptick from 2020, but still in decline from 2017.

to do better.




